On September 18, 2025, Genera PR, LLC ("Genera") filed before the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") a document titled Motion for Extension of Time to Submit Fuel Budget Report in Compliance with Section 7.3(f) of the Operation and Maintenance Agreement ("September 18 Motion").

Through the September 18 Motion, Genera requested a seven (7) day extension and/or until September 24, 2025, to file the quarterly fuel budget report established by the *Puerto Rico* Thermal Generation Facilities Operation and Maintenance Agreement ("OMA") entered between the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority ("PREPA"), Genera and the Puerto Rico Private-Public Partnership Authority ("P3 Authority").

The Energy Bureau GRANTS the requested extension and ORDERS Genera to submit the referenced report on or before September 24, 2025.

The Energy Bureau WARNS Genera that failure to comply with this Resolution and Order, will result in the imposition of fines, under Art. 6.36 of Act 57-2014.1
