LUMA's Requests in its October 7th Motion

**INFORMATIVE MOTION REAFFIRMING LUMA'S REQUESTS IN ITS OCTOBER
7TH MOTION**

TO THE HONORABLE PUERTO RICO ENERGY BUREAU:

COME now **LUMA Energy, LLC** and **LUMA Energy ServCo, LLC**, (jointly referred to as "LUMA"), and respectfully state and request the following:

1. On October 7, 2025, LUMA filed before this Puerto Rico Energy Bureau ("Energy Bureau") an *Informative Motion and Requests Relating to Timeframe to Submit Comments to Recently Issued Market Baseline and Potential Study and Timeframe Related to Draft Three-Year Plan* ("October 7th Motion"). In it, LUMA addressed the Energy Bureau's requirement set forth in the Energy Bureau's Resolution and Order of September 12, 2025, providing for stakeholders to submit comments, by October 10, 2025, to the Market Baseline and Potential Study ("Study") that was distributed to LUMA and several stakeholders on September 23, 2025. The stakeholder workshop to discuss the Study was held on September 24, 2025 – just one day following the distribution of the Study to some stakeholders.

2. In the October 7th Motion, LUMA sustained that the short period of time that was provided for review of the Study prior to the Technical Workshop limited the stakeholders' ability to ask substantive questions to and obtain actionable feedback from the Study consultants- an

important step to better position stakeholders to prepare and submit written comments. *See* October 7th Motion, p. 8. Therefore, LUMA requested that the Energy Bureau provide until November 7, 2024 for this interactive process to occur and that all parties have visibility of this process. *See id.* This position aligns with a similar request made by the Independent Consumer Protection Office during the Technical Workshop. *See id.* LUMA further requested that the timeline to submit written comments be adjusted to account for this question-and-answer process. *See id.*, p. 9.

3. Furthermore, LUMA noted that it was awaiting receipt from the Study consultants of the appendices to the Study as these appendices could not be opened in the format provided, a request that was made during the Technical Workshop. *See id.*, p. 7. In this regard, LUMA hereby informs that LUMA received all requested Study appendices on October 8, 2025, and LUMA is currently evaluating the Study in conjunction with these appendices.

4. For the same reasons stated in LUMA's October 7th Motion and in light of LUMA having received the Study appendices merely two days ago, LUMA hereby reaffirms its request that the Energy Bureau adjust the timeline to submit comments to the Study and provide the opportunity for the question-and-answer process with the Study consultants described in the October 7th Motion. Accordingly, LUMA anticipates that the Energy Bureau will issue a revised procedural calendar outlining the next steps, including opportunities for comments, questions, and engagements with the Energy Bureau's consultants.

WHEREFORE, LUMA respectfully requests that the Energy Bureau **take notice** of the aforementioned and **issue a determination** on LUMA's requests as outlined on the October 7th Motion and reaffirmed in the present motion.
