SUBJECT: Resolution and Order pertaining to *Motion Regarding Information and Documents Requested Under Resolution and Order of July 16, 2025*, filed by Global Power Solutions (PR) LLC.

RESOLUTION AND ORDER

On June 18, 2025, Global Power Solutions (PR) LLC (“Global”) filed before the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board (“Energy Bureau”) a Request for Certification as an Electric Power Service Company (“Application”) and supporting documents.

On July 16, 2025, the Energy Bureau issued a Resolution and Order (“July 16 Resolution”) in which the Energy Bureau determined that Global’s Application was incomplete and granted it thirty (30) days to submit all necessary supporting documentation to meet the requirements in Regulation 8701,¹ including:

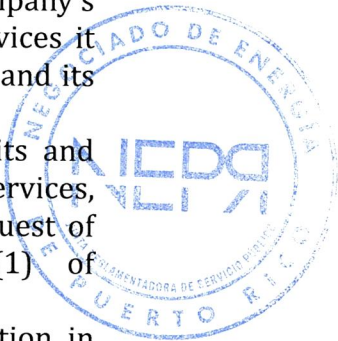
1. Certified Financial Statements
2. Human Resources Statements
3. Technical specifications of units and equipment
4. Installation locations and facility information
5. Permits, authorizations, and endorsements (“Permits”)
6. Complete operational plans and reports
7. Evidence of payment of the corresponding filing fee
8. Any additional applicable documentation enumerated in Regulation 8701

On August 15, 2025, Global filed a motion titled *Request for Extension* (August 15 Motion”), requesting the Energy Bureau a fifteen (15) day extension to submit the required documentation, which was granted on August 29, 2025.

On September 15, 2025, Global filed redacted and unredacted versions of a document titled *Motion Regarding Information and Documents Requested Under Resolution and Order of July 16, 2025* (“September 15 Motion”), whereby Global submitted redacted and unredacted versions of:

Attachment 5 – Evidence of payment of filing fees for the *Personal Information Electric Power Companies* (Form NEPR-B01) and *Operational Report Electric Power Companies* (Form NEPR-B03).

In the September 15 Motion, Global reported that it is working to submit the following additional documents requested in the July 16 Resolution:


1. Information regarding contracts of legal transaction with PREPA.
2. Certification that attests that the company has the financial capacity and solvency to finance the construction and operation of new or under renovation facilities.
3. Permits.
4. Certified Financial Statements.
5. *Gross Revenue and Financial Statements Electric Power Companies* (Form NEPR-B05).

In the September 15 Motion, Global requested:

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1. Extension of thirty (30) days to update the Energy Bureau on the remaining documents.
 2. Deferral of the *Request of Certification Electric Power Companies* (NEPR B04) Filing Fee.
 3. Exemption from Permits alleging the application of Executive Order OE-2025-016² to a Request for Proposal that Global is participating under Third-Party Procurement Office ("3PPO") and the Puerto Rico Energy Power Authority.
 4. Exemption from filing Certified Financial Statements as Global has not yet commenced operations.
 5. Exemption from filing *Gross Revenue and Financial Statements Electric Power Companies* (Form NEPR-B05) as Global has not yet commenced operations.

Through the September 15 Motion, Global reported how it intends to enhance the safety, reliability, and resilience of Puerto Rico's electrical grid, to comply with the July 16 Resolution request to show that the service it intends to offer will be reliable and will not threaten the safety and reliability of the electrical infrastructure.

Global requested confidential treatment of the September 15 Motion and its attachments. Global submitted both redacted and unredacted versions of the documents in compliance with: (i) Section 6.15 of Act 57-2014³; (ii) Section 1.15 of Regulation 8701; and (iii) *In Re: Policy on Management of Confidential Information in Procedures before the Commission*, Case No.: CEPR-MI-2016-0009, Resolution and Order issued on August 31, 2016 ("Confidential Treatment Resolution").



Under Section 3.03 of Regulation 8701, companies must provide a copy of the permits, authorizations, and federal, state, and municipal endorsements they have obtained to operate and do business in Puerto Rico and provide electric service in Puerto Rico. Under Executive Order OE-2025-016 ("Executive Order"), Gov. Jennifer Gonzalez declared a modification and extension of the electrical system emergency⁴. Under Section 1 of the Executive Order OE-2025-016, state and federal agencies must grant pertinent emergency permits and authorizations so that permit acquisition is not the obstacle or reason for delay

of the infrastructure projects under the emergency. Section 2 of the Executive Order describes the applicability of the exemption and declares that the Puerto Rico Energy Bureau will continue to execute its functions as the regulatory entity of the public energetic policy of Puerto Rico.⁵

Under Section 2.03 of Regulation 8701, for operational reports of companies offering electric services identified as "Fossil fuel or renewable energy generation with aggregated capacity of more than one hundred (100) MW" must submit to the Energy Bureau evidence of payment of \$2,000.

The Energy Bureau **DETERMINES** Global **PARTIALLY COMPLIED** with the July 16 Resolution.


The Energy Bureau **DETERMINES** Global **COMPLIED** with the evidence of payment for the Amended Request for Certification and the Personal Information Form. However, the incorrect fee amount was paid for the Operational Report . The fee for the type of electric service to be offered by Global amounts to \$2,000, not \$800 as was paid. As such, the Energy Bureau **ORDERS** Global to submit evidence of payment for the remaining balance of \$1,200, once the Agreement is formalized.

The Energy Bureau **GRANTS** Global the requested **thirty (30) day term, from the notification of this Resolution and Order**, to provide an update on the status of the Agreement and outstanding documentation.


The Energy Bureau **GRANTS** Global:


- i. Deferral of the filing fee for the Request of Certification, until the execution of the Agreement. Once the Agreement is formalized Global is required to submit filing fee payment.
- ii. Exemption from the requirement to submit Certified Financial Statements for Fiscal Year 2025 and the *Gross Revenue and Financial Statement Form* (Form NEPR-B05) for Natural Year 2024.
- iii. Exemption from submitting permits, authorizations or endorsements required, until the execution of the Agreement. Once the Agreement is formalized Global is required to provide all permits, authorizations and endorsements.
- iv. Request for confidentiality of the September 15 Motion and its attachments, under Act 57-2014 and Regulation 8701.


