**SUBJECT:** Motion Requesting Extension of the Review Period for Determination of Completeness.

## **RESOLUTION AND ORDER**

On October 17, 2025, LUMA Energy, LLC ("ManagementCo"), and LUMA Energy ServCo, LLC ("ServCo"), (jointly referred to as "LUMA") filed a document titled *Motion Requesting Extension of the Review Period for Determination of Completeness* ("October 17 Motion") before the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau").

In the October 17 Motion LUMA stated that they (a) filed a document titled *Motion Submitting 2025 IRP and Request for Confidential Treatment* in which it recommended that the Energy Bureau approve Resource Plan Hybrid A as LUMA's Preferred Resource Plan; (b) as ordered by the Energy Bureau, LUMA will file on November 21, 2025, the portion under Section 2.03(J)(2)(e) of Regulation 9021, which requires additional analysis on the Preferred Resource Plan to determine any implications it may have on the transmission and distribution system; (c) once this step is complete and in accordance with the requirement to file the Supplemental Scenarios shortly thereafter, given the complex, time-consuming process for modeling scenarios and analyzing results, LUMA will submit the Supplemental Scenarios on or before December 12, 2025. According to LUMA, the Energy Bureau's review of the 2025 IRP Filing for completeness is better served if it considers the analysis required under Section 2.03(J)(2)(e) of Regulation 9021 to perform a fulsome review of the 2025 IRP and the modeling of the Supplemental Scenarios.<sup>1</sup>

LUMA requested that the Energy Bureau take notice of the foregoing and that for purposes of determining whether the 2025 IRP filing complies with the requirements of Regulation 9021, the Energy Bureau commences that review process after LUMA has filed the Supplemental Scenarios on either December 12, 2025, or December 19, 2025.

Upon review of LUMA's arguments, the Energy Bureau **TAKES NOTICE** of the October 17 Motion and **GRANTS** LUMA **until December 19, 2025** to file the Supplemental Scenarios, the date on which the Energy Bureau will formally start the 2025 IRP filing completeness review specified in Section 3.02 (A) of Regulation 9021. The Energy Bureau **EMPHASIZES** that review of material filed on October 17, 2025 has already commenced, and while the 30-day completeness clock of Section 3.02 (A) of Regulation 9021 will not start until December, all materials filed by LUMA on October 17, 2025 are considered as final, and not as preliminary.

<sup>1</sup> Luma also pointed out that it is currently involved in the proceeding Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority Rate Review, Case No. NEPR-AP-2023- 0003 ("Rate Review Process"), which is scheduled for an evidentiary hearing from November 12 through December 19, 2025. LUMA will have to devote considerable resources and time to that proceeding during that timeframe, and many of the LUMA staff engaged in the Rate Review Process are also engaged in the 2025 IRP process.
