OBJECTION OF OFFICIAL COMMITTEE OF UNSECURED CREDITORS OF PREPA TO INTERVENOR REBUTTAL TESTIMONY

To the Honorable Puerto Rico Energy Bureau:

In accordance with the Hearing Examiner's Order on Various Prehearing Matters, issued October 29, 2025 ("October 29 Order"), Intervenor the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors of PREPA (the "Committee")1 respectfully files this objection (the "Objection") to the Rebuttal Testimony of Susan Tierney, Ph.D. ("Tierney"), a consultant retained by the Non-Settling Bondholders,² dated October 27, 2025 (the "Tierney Rebuttal Testimony"). In support of this Objection, the Committee respectfully represents, as follows:³

1. In the October 29 Order, the Hearing Examiner "eliminate[d] the debt panel" and, instead, invited all participants to address "in their post-hearing submissions ... what [debt] amount should go into rates; and by what method and procedure should reconciliation of the current amount with the Title III-determined amount occur." October 29 Order (emphasis added). Although the foregoing Order was issued two days after the deadline for submitting the Tierney Rebuttal Testimony, the Order follows a series of prior statements by the Hearing Examiner eliminating the need for any testimony of the very type and nature contained within the Tierney Rebuttal Testimony:

> Panel on debt: No one is proposing a dollar figure. And it is not clear that anyone opposes creating an empty rider. The Energy Bureau can determine the form of a rider, and any amount in it, without questioning a panel. Parties could contribute ideas on rider format via briefs or proposed orders. I therefore, tentatively, see no need for a debt panel and no need for Ms. Frayer to submit intervenor testimony relating to the PREB consultant's comments on debt. Those comments state no more than what others have stated--that until the Title III process ends, there should be no debt amount in the revenue requirement.

- 2. The Tierney Rebuttal Testimony, of course, is neither a "brief" nor "proposed order," so it does not comport with the October 17 Order. Nor, for that matter, would its admission be consistent with fairness: the Hearing Examiner "s[aw] no need" for testimony from Ms. Frayer, who planned to submit testimony on behalf of the Committee. *See Committee's Position on Panel on Debt and Objection to Proposed Orders in Lieu of Post-Hearing Briefing,* dated October 27, 2025 ("Given the Hearing Examiner's comments during the October 16 Conference and within the October 17 Order that followed, [and] the Hearing Examiner's view that no intervenor testimony by Ms. Julia Frayer is necessary at this time.... Ms. Frayer previously paused preparation of that testimony."). The Committee relied on the Hearing Examiner's remarks in not submitting Ms. Frayer's rebuttal testimony. Admitting testimony by the Non-Settling Bondholders' expert witness disguised as rebuttal testimony on the very same topic of debt would reward the Non-Settling Bondholders for ignoring the Hearing Examiner's clear direction and instructions.
- 3. Accordingly, consistent with the October 29 Order, the Tierney Rebuttal Testimony should be excluded, and all parties wishing to raise issues relating to PREPA's legacy debt should do so in their respective post-hearing briefing submissions.
