MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION

TO THE HONORABLE PUERTO RICO ENERGY BUREAU:


COMES NOW Sol Ecolution Puerto Rico LLC ("SEPR") through the undersigned legal counsel, and respectfuly states, submits and requests the following:

- 1. SEPR filed before the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") a Request for Certification as an Electric Power Service Company ("Application") on December 27, 2024.
- 2. In Response to the Application, the Energy Bureau entered a Resolution on March 18, 2025 deeming the Application as incomplete and granting SEPR thirty (30) days to submit the following, which were filed and submitted to the Energy Bureau on March 21, 2025:
 - a. copies of any permits, authorizations, and/or endorsements related to the system issued in favor of SEPR;
 - clarification about the statement regarding uninterruptible service in the operational report; and

- c. description of how SEPR is billing customers associated with the installations in Appendix B of the Application.
- 3. On April 16, 2025, personnel from the Energy Bureau contacted SEPR requesting that Form NEPR-B03 included with the Application be amended. Thus, SEPR submitted to Energy Bureau the amended form on April 22, 2025.
- 4. On May 9, 2025, the Energy Bureau entered a Resolution and Order granting SEPR's request of Certification and ordering NEPR to file within 15 days the requirements to comply with Regulation 8863, meaning the contents and format of the electric bills and publication of the Informal Administrative Procedure for Objecting to Electric Bills.
- 5. In compliance with the Energy Bureau's May 9th Resolution, SEPR submitted for approval a model invoice and evidence of the publication of the Informal Administrative Procedure.
- 6. On August 29, 2025, the Energy Bureau entered a Resolution and Order requiring SEPR to file within 15 days (a) evidence of payment of the applicable filing fee according to the type of electric service, (b) revised electric services bill including reference to publication of the informal procedure for objecting electric bills.
- 7. On September 12, 2025, SEPR submitted evidence of the payment and a revised invoice layout seeking to address the deficiencies indicated by the Energy Bureau in its Aug. 29th order.
- 8. On October 21, 2025, the Energy Bureau entered a Resolution and Order holding SEPR had partially complied with the Aug. 29th order recognizing payment had been made by SEPR but deeming that the hyperlink www.solecolution.com in SEPR's

invoice does not include the procedure for reconsideration or the procedure to request formal revision by the Energy Bureau (the "Oct. 21st Order").

- 9. However, the website www.solecolution.com does include the procedures for reconsideration and to request formal revision by the Energy Bureau (the "Energy Bureau's Administrative Procedures"). At the bottom of the initial page of that website there are links titled "PR Administrative Procedures" and "PR Forms" which take you to the Energy Bureau's Administrative Procedures.
 - 10. The following images shows the links' location on SEPR's website:



Hence, SEPR did comply with the requirement to publish the PR Administrative Procedures pursuant to Regulation 8863.

11. In order to make the publication of the PR Administrative Procedures more readily available, considering the Energy Bureau's Oct. 21st Order, SEPR has programed a change in its website and invoice to include the following hyperlink that would go directly to the Energy Bureau's Administrative Procedures: www.solecolution/procedures.

WHEREFORE, SEPR respectfully requests that the Energy Bureau take notice of the aforementioned and reconsider its Oct. 21st Order and deem SEPR's invoice as presented in Exhibit 1 as compliant with Regulation 8863.
