various motions, filed by Nuscan CSP.

RESOLUTION AND ORDER

On June 13, 2025, the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") issued a Resolution and Order ("June 13 Resolution"), whereby it determined Nuscan CSP's ("Nuscan") *Request for Microgrid Registration* was incomplete and granted it twenty (20) days to submit all the necessary documentation to enable the proper evaluation of its request, in accordance with Regulation 9028.¹

On July 8, 2025, Nuscan filed a document titled *Clarification in Support of the Application for Registration of a Microgrid* ("July 8 Motion") with certain information and documentation in response to the June 13 Resolution.

On October 15, 2025, Nuscan filed the revised document titled *Clarification in Support of the Application for Registration of a Microgrid* ("October 15 Motion") with a list of changes in comparison with the July 8 Motion:

1. Compliance with "Renewable Microgrid" classification. The confirmation is made explicit in the section of the same title on page 6.
2. Appendix A: Plans duly signed and stamped by the engineer in charge of the project.
3. Appendix B: Amendment to the lease agreement between Nuscan and Hiram Investments, Inc., allowing the use not only of the existing roofs of the property owned by Hiram Investments, Inc., but also of the parking lots.
4. Appendix B: Authorizations for the use of the intermediate plots to bury the electrical conductors that will transport the energy between the property owned by Hiram Investments and Nuscan.
5. Appendix C: Affidavit explaining the consolidation of previous parcels² into the new parcel³ referenced in the lease agreement between the parties.
6. Appendix D: Certification of compliance with applicable rules and standards signed by the engineer in charge of the project.

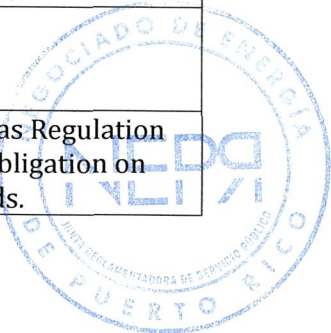





After reviewing the October 15 Motion, the Energy Bureau **DETERMINES** Nuscan Request for Microgrid Registration is **COMPLETE**. As such, the Energy Bureau **REGISTERS** Nuscan as a Personal Microgrid.


Notwithstanding Nuscan’s system classification as a Personal Microgrid, the Energy Bureau **ADVISES** Nuscan that this classification is contingent upon the system not selling excess Energy Services or Grid Services to any person other than its owner(s) or PREPA/LUMA. Under Section 2.02(C) of Regulation 9028, the sale of **excess** energy or services to third parties is strictly prohibited unless the Microgrid first obtains **express authorization from the Energy Bureau through filing a detailed petition describing the proposed agreement**.

Additionally, although Section 2.02(A) permits a Personal Microgrid to provide energy to PREPA/LUMA, Nuscan is **WARNED** that large-scale exports of energy to PREPA may similarly alter the operational character of the system. Any such activity may fall outside the scope of a Personal Microgrid under Section 2.01(B)(1) and would require Nuscan to return to the Energy Bureau for evaluation before commencing such sales. The Energy Bureau may then determine that the system is subject to additional regulatory requirements.
