RESOLUTION AND ORDER

I. INTRODUCTION AND BACKGROUND

am This Resolution and Order addresses a request by the Solar and Energy Storage Association of Puerto Rico ("SESA") on January 17, 2026. SESA sought to include all material numbered 462 and higher in the evidentiary record, and to partially modify the Hearing Examiner's January 8, 2026, Order ("January 8 Order"). The Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") issued a Resolution and Order that considered similar issues on January 16, 2026 ("January 16 Order"). SESA raises no new arguments and the Energy Bureau affirms the January 116 Order

7/16 On January 17, 2026, SESA filed a document titled *Motion for Bureau to Confirm Inclusion of All Exhibits Numbered 462 and Higher in the Record and to Partially Modify the Hearing Examiner's January 8, 2026, Order, if Necessary*. Specifically, SESA asks the Energy Bureau to admit all material marked for identification starting with Exhibit 462. Additionally, to the extent necessary, SESA asks that the Energy Bureau vacate the Hearing Examiner's January 8 Order in so far as it excluded material numbered beginning with 926.

Smr SESA argues:

- The Energy Bureau should exercise its independent judgment to determine what evidentiary record best serves fairness, transparency, administrative regularity, and judicial review.
- The distinction made for admission of material beginning with 926 is arbitrary as those materials were excluded merely by timing and numbering, not relevance, reliability or probative value.
- Notice was not provided that failure to introduce material beginning with 926 would result in forfeiture of evidence for purpose of the final record.
- All material numbered 462 and above should be admitted and given the weight it deserves.

San The Energy Bureau affirmed in the January 16 Order,¹ admission of Exhibits 462-925 admitted by the Hearing Examiner. The January 16 Order also addressed the distinction made for materials beginning with 926, including the notice argument.

¹ The Energy Bureau was not asked to and did not overrule any exhibits the Hearing Examiner rejected between 462-925 and SESA did not timely file a request for reconsideration of any of those decisions.




II. CONCLUSION






