SUBJECT: Resolution and Order pertaining to *PREPA's Motion for the Energy Bureau to Reconsider and Vacate Hearing Examiner Order Compelling Production of Prior Drafts of the FTI Report*, filed by the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority.

RESOLUTION AND ORDER

On January 1, 2026, the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority (the "PREPA") requested that the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") set aside certain aspects of an order issued by the Hearing Examiner ("January 1 Motion") on December 22, 2025 in this case (the "December 22 Order").¹ Specifically, PREPA requested that the Energy Bureau vacate the portion of the December 22 Order requiring PREPA to produce the draft versions of a report prepared by FTI Consulting concerning an accounting remediation plan for PREPA, as well as the emails exchanged by the parties in connection with that report.

Upon evaluating the arguments raised by PREPA, the December 22 Order, and considering the incidences of the adjudicative hearings in this case and the way the proceeding has been conducted, the Energy Bureau **DENIES** the January 1 Motion. Accordingly, PREPA is **ORDERED** to produce, within the **five (5) days**, the draft versions of the referenced FTI Consulting report. However, the Energy Bureau determines that, at this time and given the procedural stage of the case, it will not require the production of emails or other related documents.² PREPA's obligation is limited to the submission of FTI's Consulting draft reports. Such draft reports shall be submitted as confidential documents and designated as such, and that confidential designation shall be maintained under the provisions established by the Hearing Examiner in this case governing the handling of confidential documents, unless the Energy Bureau determines otherwise regarding their confidentiality.


