**SUBJECT:** LUMA's Motion Requesting Order Granting Leave to Proceed with Revised Presentation Template

**MOTION REQUESTING ORDER GRANTING LEAVE TO PROCEED WITH  
REVISED PRESENTATION TEMPLATE**

**TO THE PUERTO RICO ENERGY BUREAU:**

COME NOW, LUMA ENERGY, LLC as Management Co., and LUMA ENERGY SERVCO, LLC (collectively, "LUMA"), through the respective undersigned legal counsel and respectfully state and submit the following:

**I. Introduction**

Pursuant to the directives of the Puerto Rico Energy Bureau ("Energy Bureau"), LUMA respectfully submits this motion in connection with the Interconnections Progress Report submitted on a quarterly basis in this docket. LUMA submitted for the Energy Bureau's consideration and approval an updated template for the quarterly Distributed Generation Interconnections Progress Report. The revised format is intended to improve clarity, eliminate redundancies, strengthen narrative structure, and enhance transparency and regulatory review while maintaining full adherence to all applicable reporting requirements. LUMA submits this motion requesting the Energy Bureau's approval of the updated template for the quarterly Distributed Generation Interconnections Progress Report before it submits the next quarterly report on February 13, 2026.

**II. Procedural Background**

1. LUMA hereby incorporates by reference the procedural background included in Section II of the *Motion Submitting Interconnections Progress Report for July Through September 2025 and Supporting Material* filed with the Clerk of the Honorable Puerto Rico Energy Bureau (“Energy Bureau”) on November 14, 2025 (“Motion”).

2. With the Motion, and in compliance with the orders entered in this docket on July 21, 2020, May 7, 2021, April 4, 2024, and July 12, 2024, LUMA submitted the Interconnections Progress Report for the July-September 2025 quarter, adhering to the requirements outlined in the July 21, 2020, Order. *See* Motion, Exhibit 1. LUMA also submitted the Distributed Generation Systems Data File (“DG Data File”), the DG Data File divided by customer class, including residential, commercial, industrial, and agricultural. *See id.*, Exhibit 2 and Exhibit 3. Furthermore, in compliance with the Order entered on August 27, 2021, LUMA filed a copy of the materials to be used in the compliance hearing in connection with the applicable Interconnections Progress Report. *See id.*, Exhibit 4.

3. Furthermore, and in connection with the purpose of this motion, with the Motion, LUMA proposed to the Energy Bureau the adoption of an updated template for the quarterly Distributed Generation Interconnections Progress Report. As explained in the Motion, the proposed revised format, attached to the Motion as Exhibit 5, has been developed pursuant to the Energy Bureau’s orders of April 4, 2024, and July 12, 2024, and reflects operational lessons and feedback received during the compliance hearings. The intent of the update is to maintain full adherence to the Energy Bureau’s requirements while improving the structure, narrative flow, and analytical clarity of the quarterly filings, and aligning them with the terminology established in laws and regulations.

4. The proposed format reorganizes the presentation to eliminate repetition, clarify process steps, and consolidate indicators that had previously appeared on multiple slides. The table

included as Exhibit 5 to the Motion, and which is incorporated by reference herein, identifies the principal adjustments between the August 2025 presentation deck (covering April–June 2025) and the newly proposed template for the July–September 2025 presentation.

5. LUMA respectfully asserts that these changes preserve all quantitative and narrative elements required under the orders entered on July 21, 2020, April 4, 2024, and July 12, 2024, while reorganizing the report into a more cohesive, narrative-driven structure. Each table, chart, and figure in the revised presentation directly corresponds to one of the Energy Bureau’s requirements: total interconnection applications, indicators for elapsed time, backlog segmentation, and renewable generation MWh, among others.

6. The updated version also introduces new explanatory diagrams illustrating (i) the Interconnections Process Flow, from application completion to final tariff activation; and (ii) the Developer Upgrade Process, clarifying the sequence and accountability for system reinforcements or supplemental studies.

7. LUMA reaffirms that all the required datasets, including the Interconnection Progress Report (Exhibit 1), the DG Data File (Exhibit 2) and the DG Data by Customer Class (Exhibit 3) will continue to be submitted without modifications, thus adhering to the Energy Bureau’s orders.

8. LUMA respectfully asserts that the proposed template will facilitate greater transparency, enhance comparability across quarters, and promote a more efficient review process for the Energy Bureau and stakeholders. Upon the Energy Bureau’s approval, LUMA intends to implement the revised format beginning with the October-December 2025 reporting period. Further, if allowed, LUMA will use the presentation during the next compliance hearing.

9. Currently, the next compliance hearing is scheduled for February 23, 2026, at 10 a.m. However, LUMA respectfully moves to reschedule the hearing to a date during the week of March

9 to 13, 2026 due to the unavailability of Mr. Charles Tweten for personal and medical reasons. Mr. Tweten is an important witness for LUMA, whose participation in the hearings is essential to maximizing their usefulness for the Energy Bureau and the general public.

10. In the interest of administrative efficiency, LUMA respectfully requests the Energy Bureau to approve use of the updated template for the quarterly Distributed Generation Interconnections Progress Report by February 2, 2026, allowing LUMA to prepare the upcoming quarterly report according to the Energy Bureau's preference.

### **III. Conclusion**

The revised format for the quarterly Distributed Generation Interconnections Progress Report preserves all required reporting elements, enhances clarity and organization, strengthens transparency, and supports a more efficient regulatory review process. LUMA stands ready to implement the updated template beginning with the October–December 2025 reporting period and to use it during the upcoming compliance hearing. Approval of the updated template by February 2, 2026, would enhance the overall value of the report, as it would allow LUMA to align it more effectively with the Energy Bureau's expectations for efficiency. LUMA requests that the Energy Bureau reschedule the compliance hearing set to be celebrated on February 23, 2026, to a date during the week of March 9 to 13, 2026.

**WHEREFORE**, LUMA respectfully requests that the Energy Bureau take notice of the foregoing, grant leave to utilize the proposed updated template for the quarterly Distributed Generation Interconnections Progress Report as the standard presentation format and reschedules the February 23, 2026's compliance hearing to a date during the week of March 9 to 13, 2026.
