SUBJECT: Motion to Inform Scheduled On-Site Visit at The San Juan Power Plant in Compliance with Resolution and Order Issued January 30, 2026

MOTION TO INFORM SCHEDULED ON-SITE VISIT AT THE SAN JUAN POWER PLANT IN COMPLIANCE WITH RESOLUTION AND ORDER ISSUED JANUARY 30, 2026

TO THE HONORABLE PUERTO RICO ENERGY BUREAU:

1. On January 30, 2026, the Puerto Rico Energy Bureau (“Energy Bureau”) issued a Resolution and Order (“January 30th Order”) in which it noted various media outlets had reported the failure of ten (10) temporary generation units.
2. In the January 30th Order, the Energy Bureau, citing its delegated authority and the establishment of the Project Inspection Program on June 16, 2025, ordered Genera PR LLC (“Genera”) to coordinate, within ten (10) days, an urgent on-site visit at the San Juan Power Plant with the Energy Bureau’s consultants to address not only issues related to the ten (10) temporary generation units, but also all temporary generation units installed or operating within the electric system.
3. In compliance with the January 30th Order, Genera hereby informs the Energy Bureau that it timely coordinated the requested on-site visit. The visit took place on February 12, 2026, at the San Juan Power Plant, with the participation of the Energy Bureau’s

consultants and the responsible Genera personnel, including individuals in charge of the temporary generation units.

4. Genera acknowledges the importance of the matters raised in the January 30th Order and reaffirms its full cooperation with the Energy Bureau in connection with the Project Inspection Program and matters concerning the temporary generation units under its operational responsibility.

WHEREFORE, Genera respectfully requests that this Energy Bureau **take notice** of the above for all purposes and **deem** Genera to be in compliance with the January 30th Order.
