MOTION IN SUPPORT OF LUMA'S REQUEST FOR CONTINUANCE OF HEARING

TO THE HONORABLE ENERGY BUREAU:

COMES NOW the Puerto Rico Solar Energy Industries Association Corp. dba Solar and Energy Storage Association of Puerto Rico ("SESA"), represented by the undersigned legal counsel, and very respectfully prays and requests:

1. SESA is an association that represents Puerto Rico's solar and energy storage industries. It advocates solar and storage technologies as a central solution to the energy needs of Puerto Rico and promotes public policy that benefits the growth of these industries. It brings awareness and understanding of these technologies to both government policymakers and the public and facilitates collectively beneficial collaboration and good business practices within the industry.
2. Via its *Motion Submitting Interconnection Progress Report for October-December 2025 and Requesting Order for Continuance of Hearing* filed on February 13th in this docket, LUMA requested the continuance of the February 23, 2026 hearing, expressing the following:

“9. On January 27, 2026, LUMA filed a motion titled “Motion Requesting Order Granting Leave to Proceed with Revised Presentation Template”, requesting a continuance of the upcoming compliance hearing, currently scheduled for February 23, 2026, to a date within the week of March 9–13, 2026, due to the unavailability of Mr. Charles Tweten for personal and medical reasons. LUMA stated, and hereby restates, that Mr. Tweten is a key witness whose participation is essential to ensure a complete and informative presentation to the Energy Bureau and the public.

10. In the interest of efficiency and to ensure the availability of the personnel necessary to discuss the material customarily reviewed during compliance hearings, including the data, analyses, and follow up matters associated with the materials submitted through this Motion, LUMA respectfully renews its request for a continuance. This request is made in good faith, following reasonable efforts to avoid postponement, and will not prejudice any other party.”

3. SESA fully agrees with LUMA’s rationale and consequently supports its request to the Honorable Bureau of a continuance of the February 23, 2026 Hearing, to a date within the week of March 9th to 13th of 2026.

WHEREFORE, the Solar and Energy Storage Association respectfully requests that the Puerto Rico Energy Bureau grant the requested continuance of the February 23d, 2026 Hearing to a date within the week of March 9th to 13th of 2026.
