SUBJECT: Resolution and Order – Monthly Report

RESOLUTION AND ORDER

On March 28, 2025, the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board (“Energy Bureau”) issued a Resolution and Order (“March 28 Resolution”), through which, the Energy Bureau established the Electric System Priority Stabilization Two-Year Plan (“PSP”). Through the March 28 Resolution, the Energy Bureau ordered LUMA, Genera, and PREPA to provide a monthly report of the activities established in the PSP.

Through this Resolution and Order the Energy Bureau modifies the requirements of the monthly report. The required modifications to the monthly report and the activities reported therein are described below.

A. Targeted Vegetation Management Program:

The current report presents accumulated work only, so a comparison between the work performed in the current month and that of the prior month is not possible. When comparing reports, some lines are included and/or excluded which makes it difficult to track activities. There are no clear targets, and the expected amount of work is not defined.

The Modified Monthly Report shall include all distribution and transmission lines worked during the fiscal year. It shall also include activities performed during the current month, the prior month, the accumulated amount and the targets.

B. Vegetation Clearing


The current report presents only the accumulated work, specified by region.

The Modified Monthly Report shall include all distribution and transmission lines worked during the fiscal year. It shall also include activities performed during the current month, the prior month, the accumulated amount and the targets.

C. Complete Transmission Line Hardening & Maintenance

The current report presents only the 51 segments worked during the month. There is no clear description of the work conducted in each segment. The report does not include the status of the transmission line hardening projects included in the PSP – priority stabilization plan.

The Modified Monthly Report shall include a table with all 51 segments. Said table shall present work performed for each segment describing the conducted activity during the month including insulation and hardware replacement, pole replacement, hot spot repairs, switch repairs and others. Total accumulated work per segment shall also be included. It shall also include activities performed during the current month, the prior month, the accumulated amount and the targets. The Modified Report must include the list of all projects included in Priority Stabilization Plan and be identified as such.




In conclusion, for clarity and ease of analysis, the Energy Bureau **ORDERS** LUMA to include all the above-mentioned modifications in all future reports.

The Energy Bureau **WARNS** Genera that, in accordance Art. 6.36 of Act 57-2014:

- i. noncompliance with this Resolution and Order, regulations and/or applicable laws may carry the imposition of fines and administrative sanctions of up to \$125,000 per day; and
- ii. for any recurrence of non-compliance or violation, the established penalty shall increase to a fine of not less than ten thousand dollars (\$15,000) nor greater than twenty thousand dollars (\$250,000), at the discretion of the Energy Bureau.


