**MOTION TO REQUEST CONFIDENTIAL TREATMENT OF
2026 GROSS REVENUES REPORT**

TO THE HONORABLE ENERGY BUREAU:

COMES NOW SunEdison Puerto Rico, LLC ("SunEdison"), represented by the undersigned legal counsel, and respectfully submits the following:

1. Section 4.02(B) of the *Amendment to Regulation No. 8618 on Certification, Annual Fees, and Operational Plans for Electric Service Companies in Puerto Rico, Regulation 8701 of the 17th of February 2016*, as amended ("Regulation 8701") mandates all electric service companies operating in Puerto Rico to whom the Honorable Energy Bureau has issued a Certification to inform the Energy Bureau of their annual gross revenue within a period of sixty (60) days following the conclusion of the natural year.
2. SunEdison hereby complies with Section 4.02(B) of Regulation 8701 by informing the Honorable Energy Bureau of its gross revenues for fiscal year 2025 and submitting the Gross Revenue and Financial Statement Form. (**Attachment 1**).
3. SunEdison requests that confidential treatment be afforded to this motion's corresponding attachment. Section 6.15 of Act No. 57 of May 17, 2014, as amended, 22 L.P.R.A. § 1054n, provides:

If any person who is required to submit information to the Energy [Bureau] believes that the information to be submitted has any confidentiality

privilege, such person may request the [Bureau] to treat such information as such, subject to the following:

(a) If the Energy [Bureau], after the appropriate evaluation, believes such information should be protected, it shall grant such protection in a manner that least affects the public interest, transparency, and the rights of the parties involved in the administrative procedure in which the allegedly confidential document is submitted.

(b) To such purposes, the Energy [Bureau] shall provide access to the document or the privileged portion of the document only to the lawyers and external consultants involved in the administrative process after the execution of a confidentiality agreement.

(c) The Energy [Bureau] shall keep the documents submitted for its consideration out of public reach only in exceptional cases. In these cases, the information shall be duly safeguarded and delivered exclusively to the personnel of the Energy [Bureau] who needs to know such information under nondisclosure agreements. However, the Energy [Bureau] shall direct that a non-confidential copy be furnished for public review.

(d) The Energy [Bureau] shall swiftly act on any privilege and confidentiality claim made by a person subject to its jurisdiction by means of a resolution to such purposes before any allegedly confidential information is disclosed.

4. In turn, Section 1.15 of the Regulation No. 8701 provides that when a person who is required to submit information to the Energy Bureau considers such information to be privileged or confidential, the person shall identify the information it deems privileged or confidential, request the Energy Bureau to protect such information, and present arguments supporting the privilege or confidentiality claim. The Energy Bureau shall evaluate the petition and, if it concludes the information merits protection, it shall proceed pursuant to Section 6.15 of Act No. 57.

5. SunEdison respectfully requests that all the information contained in the documents attached hereto (**Attachment 1**) be kept confidential in accordance with Section 1.15 of Regulation 8701. SunEdison is a privately held company. Its financial information is confidential, of sensitive nature, and not available to the public. the disclosure of SunEdison's financial information would place it at a competitive disadvantage with respect to other market participants and cause it economic harm.

6. In compliance with Section 6.15 of Act 57-2014, Section 1.15 of Regulation 8701 and the In Re: Policy on Management of Confidential Information in Procedures Before the Commission, CEPR-MI-2016-0009, August 31-2016, Resolution ("Confidential Treatment Resolution"), SunEdison is filing a redacted version of the information and documents for which it is requesting Confidential Treatment.

7. SunEdison respectfully requests that the Energy Bureau only grant access to the information contained in the document attached hereto to internal Energy Bureau personnel, counsel, and consultants subject to the execution of a confidentiality agreement.

WHEREFORE, SunEdison Puerto Rico, LLC respectfully requests that the Honorable take notice of SunEdison's gross revenues for fiscal year 2025 and that confidential treatment be afforded to this motion and its corresponding attachments.
