RESOLUTION AND ORDER

On February 25, 2026, Crowley Advanced Energy Puerto Rico, LLC (“Crowley”) filed before the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board (“Energy Bureau”) a document titled *Informative Motion Request for Waiver and Request for Confidential Treatment* (“February 25 Motion”) submitting: (i) *Operational Report Electric Power Companies* (Form NEPR-B03) for 2025; and (ii) *Gross Revenue and Financial Statements Report Electric Power Companies* (Form NEPR-B05), with their corresponding annexes. Crowley filed Redacted and Unredacted version of both documents, and its attachments, in compliance with Section 6.15 of Act 57-2014¹; Section 1.15 of Regulation 8701²; and *In Re: Policy on Management of Confidential Information in Procedures before the Commission*, Case No.: CEPR-MI-2016-0009, Resolution and Order issued on August 31, 2016 (“Confidential Treatment Resolution”).


In the February 25 Motion Crowley requested: (i) confidential treatment for both documents and its attachments; and (ii) to be waived the requirement for payment of the filing fee corresponding to the submission of the operational report.

Upon reviewing the reasons reported in the February 25 Motion, the Energy Bureau **TAKES NOTICE** of its Form NEPR-B03, Form NEPR-B05, and corresponding annexes, and **GRANTS** Crowley the requested confidential designation and treatment to the unredacted version of its Form NEPR-B03 and NEPR-B05 and attachments, pursuant to Act 57-2014 and Regulation 8701. The Energy Bureau **WAIVES** the requirement to pay the filing fee for its Operational Report under the provisions of Section 2.02(D) of Regulation 8701.




