**SUBJECT:** LUMA's Second Motion Submitting and Substituting Interconnections Progress Report for October-December 2025

**MOTION SUBMITTING SECOND REVISED INTERCONNECTIONS PROGRESS REPORT FOR OCTOBER-DECEMBER 2025 AND RELATED DOCUMENTS**

**TO THE PUERTO RICO ENERGY BUREAU:**

COME NOW, LUMA ENERGY, LLC as Management Co., and LUMA ENERGY SERVCO, LLC (collectively, "LUMA"), through the respective undersigned legal counsel and respectfully state and submit the following:

**I. Introduction**

Pursuant to the directives of the Puerto Rico Energy Bureau ("Energy Bureau"), LUMA respectfully submits this motion to correct and substitute certain exhibits previously filed with the Energy Bureau on February 13, 2026, and further corrected on March 6, 2026. The submission of the interconnection reports is made in compliance with the Energy Bureau's Resolutions and Orders, including those issued on July 21, 2020, May 7, 2021, April 4, 2024, and July 12, 2024. On March 12, 2026, the DG Interconnection Progress Report Compliance Hearing was held. During the hearing, LUMA made reference to some data in Exhibit 4 that warranted revisions. To ensure that the Energy Bureau evaluates the most accurate and precise data, and to facilitate review by the Energy Bureau, participants and the public, LUMA is submitting a revised and corrected version of Exhibit 4 that entirely supersedes that filed on February 13, 2026, and further corrected on March 6, 2026. This submission is made in good faith, and with no intention of causing delays or undue burden.

## II. Procedural Background

1. In compliance with multiple orders entered by the Energy Bureau in the captioned case, on February 13, 2026, LUMA submitted a document titled *Motion Submitting Interconnections Progress Report for October-December 2025 and Requesting Order for Continuance of Hearing* ("February 13 Motion").

2. With the February 13 Motion, LUMA submitted four exhibits, to wit:

- a. Exhibit 1 - the Interconnections Progress Report for the October through December 2025 quarter;
- b. Exhibit 2 - the Distributed Generation Systems Data File ("DG Data File");
- c. Exhibit 3 - the DG Data File divided by customer class, including residential, commercial, industrial, and agricultural; and
- d. Exhibit 4 - the visual presentation to be used on the March 12, 2026, Compliance Hearing.

3. On March 6, 2026, LUMA submitted a *Motion Submitting Revised Interconnections Progress Report for October-December 2025 and Related Documents* by which LUMA informed this Honorable Energy Bureau that inconsistencies were identified on slides 20-28 of Exhibit 4 and submitted a revised version correcting them. In essence, the accredited energy values appeared higher than the energy exported. Upon reviewing the underlying Excel report submitted as Exhibit 3 to the February 13 Motion, LUMA found that the formula used to calculate the "energy credited" metric for the last semester contained an error. Once the formula was corrected, the issue was resolved, and the results now align as expected ("March 6 Motion").

### **III. Need for Revision and Substitution of Exhibits**

4. On March 12, 2026, the DG Interconnection Progress Report Compliance Hearing was held. During the hearing, LUMA referenced some data in Exhibit 4 that warranted revisions. Additionally, LUMA identified inconsistencies on slides 4, 10, 15, 27, and 28 of Exhibit 4. To ensure that the Energy Bureau evaluates the most accurate and precise data, and to facilitate review by the Energy Bureau, participants and the public, LUMA is submitting a revised and corrected version of Exhibit 4 that entirely supersedes that filed on February 13, 2026, and further corrected on March 6, 2026.

5. As previously done, to ease review of the information and to promote efficiency, LUMA is submitting the entire set of documents originally presented with the February 13 Motion, further corrected in the March 6 Motion. This approach ensures that when the Energy Bureau, participants, and the public wish to refer to the documents, they can consult a single, complete, and accurate set of materials rather than reviewing multiple filings. Thus, LUMA is hereby submitting the following documents entirely correct and substituting those submitted with the February 13 Motion, further corrected in the March 6 Motion:

- a. Exhibit 1 - the Interconnections Progress Report for the October through December 2025 quarter;
- b. Exhibit 2 - the Distributed Generation Systems Data File ("DG Data File");
- c. Exhibit 3 - the DG Data File divided by customer class, including residential, commercial, industrial, and agricultural; and
- d. Exhibit 4 - the corrected visual presentation (slides) used on the March 12, 2026, Compliance Hearing.

6. LUMA respectfully states that it is submitting these revisions as soon as practicable. Further, LUMA states that this submission and request for substitution is made in good faith, to advance the purposes of these proceedings, and with no intention of causing delays or imposing undue burden on the Energy Bureau, participants, or the public.

#### **IV. Conclusion**

**WHEREFORE**, LUMA respectfully requests that the Energy Bureau:

- Take notice of the foregoing;
- Accept the revised and corrected Interconnections Progress Report for the October through December 2025 quarter, submitted as Exhibit 1;
- Accept the DG Data File, submitted as Exhibit 2;
- Accept the DG Data File divided by customer class, including residential, commercial, industrial, and agricultural, submitted as Exhibit 3; and
- Accept the revised and corrected visual presentation (slides) submitted as Exhibit 4; and
- Grant such other relief as may be just and proper.
