**JOINT SUBMISSION OF PROPOSED TRANSCRIPT CORRECTIONS AND NOTICE
REGARDING FINALIZATION TIMELINE**

**TO THE HONORABLE PUERTO RICO ENERGY BUREAU, AND ITS HEARING
EXAMINER, MR. SCOTT HEMPLING:**

COME NOW LUMA Energy, LLC and LUMA Energy ServCo, LLC, (jointly referred to as “LUMA”), and respectfully state and request the following:

1. Following the conclusion of a six-week long evidentiary hearing held in the captioned proceeding, on December 22, 2025, the Hearing Examiner issued an *Order on Exhibits, Miscellaneous Post-Hearing Matters, and Legal Issues* (“December 22nd Order”).

2. In what is here pertinent, the Hearing Examiner directed that the parties – not the Puerto Rico Energy Bureau (“Energy Bureau”) – manage the production and distribution of hearing transcripts. The Hearing Examiner set March 27, 2026 as the deadline for joint transcript corrections and ordered LUMA’s counsel to organize a process for exchanging and discussing proposed corrections culminating in a single joint submission. The December 22nd Order further required that any disagreements over corrections be stated in a single appendix showing the page, line number, and specific substance of each disagreement, and mandated that corrections be confined to transcriber error.

3. In compliance with the December 22nd Order, LUMA’s counsel organized the aforementioned transcript correction process, and the parties have collaboratively and arduously

worked toward full compliance with the Hearing Examiner's directives. Through this process, the parties have identified necessary corrections to the hearing transcripts and have prepared their proposed corrections for joint submission in accordance with the procedures established by the Hearing Examiner. The parties' jointly proposed corrections are submitted herewith. *See Exhibit A.*

4. The court reporter, Bonard, has advised that due to availability constraints over the next month, it is unable to review and incorporate the parties' proposed corrections into the official transcripts until approximately April 30, 2026. Accordingly, this joint submission of proposed corrections is filed subject to Bonard's review and acceptance of the corrections contained herein. To the extent Bonard later identifies any transcription-related issues or declines to incorporate any proposed edits, the parties will address those matters promptly upon receipt of Bonard's feedback.

5. LUMA respectfully requests that the Energy Bureau take notice that the finalized official transcripts incorporating the jointly proposed corrections herein are expected to be produced by Bonard on or about April 30, 2026. LUMA will ensure the finalized transcripts are filed with the Energy Bureau promptly upon receipt from Bonard.

6. LUMA respectfully submits that this filing is made in good faith and in compliance with the March 27, 2026 deadline for joint submission of proposed transcript corrections established by the December 22nd Order. Moreover, LUMA represents that all parties to this proceeding have been informed of the approach set forth herein. The parties who have consented to said approach are as follows: LUMA, Bondholders, and Genera, PR LLC. The remaining parties did not state their position.

WHEREFORE, LUMA respectfully requests that the Energy Bureau **accept** the jointly proposed transcript corrections filed herewith; and **take notice** that the finalized official transcripts incorporating such corrections are expected to be produced by Bonard on or about April 30, 2026.
