**RESOLUTION AND ORDER**

**I. Introduction**

On April 22, 2019, the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") issued a Resolution and Order granting COSSMA, Inc. ("COSMA") status as a registered renewable microgrid under the requirements of Regulation 9028<sup>1,2</sup>.

**II. Applicable Laws and Regulations**

Section 5.12 of Regulation 9028 requires from microgrid operators the following reports to be submitted to the Energy Bureau on an annual basis:

A. Microgrid Operators shall be required to submit an annual report on fuel usage, generation, and sales to the Energy Bureau. This report shall include:

1. Electric generation by resource type;
2. Thermal generation by resource type, for CHP Microgrids;
3. Fuel use by resource type;
4. Capacity factor by month and year;
5. Total sales;
6. Any change in the number of Customers, including additions and departures of Customers; and
7. Any other information that the Energy Bureau may require.

B. Microgrid Operators must maintain and submit to the Energy Bureau copies of any reports required by the US EPA and the Puerto Rico Environmental Quality Board.

Section 3.04(A) of Regulation 9028 requires that Renewable Microgrids must submit the following type of report:

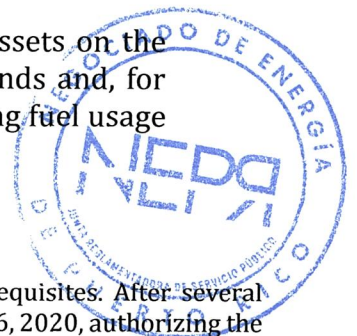
A. Renewable Microgrids must demonstrate compliance with the qualifications in Section 3.03 (A) of this Regulation. The following three alternatives for demonstrating compliance are acceptable. Applicants shall select the preferred alternative and identify such in the application for registration.

1. Operational Plan.

Include an operational plan describing the type of generation assets on the Microgrid and how they will be used to meet anticipated demands and, for each year thereafter, submit an annual operational report detailing fuel usage

and demonstrating compliance with the qualification in Section 3.03 (A) of this Regulation.

2. Oil- and gas-fired generators.

Renewable Microgrid with generating assets limited to solar photovoltaics and oil- or natural gas-fired generators shall be assumed to comply with these requirements if it consumes less than a monthly fossil fuel limit, as calculated using the template provided in Appendix A of this Regulation and submitted along with its application.

Microgrids shall maintain monthly records of fuel consumption, and submit an annual fuel consumption report for each year the Microgrid is in operation.

3. Diesel -fired generators.

Any Renewable Microgrid with generating assets limited to solar photovoltaics and diesel-fired generators shall be assumed to comply with these requirements if it consumes less than 3.5 gallons of diesel fuel per month per kilowatt of photovoltaic capacity. Microgrids shall maintain monthly records of fuel consumption, and submit an annual fuel consumption report for each year the Microgrid is in operation.

### III. Conclusion

According to the administrative record, COSSMA has not submitted the required reports in compliance with the requirements set forth in Sections 3.04(A) and 5.12 of Regulation 9028.

The Energy Bureau **GRANTS** COSSMA **twenty (20) days**, from the notification of this Resolution and Order, to submit the reports of the corresponding years since the date of its certification.

The Energy Bureau **WARNS** COSSMA that non-compliance with this Resolution and Order may result in the imposition of fines under Art. 6.36 of Act 57-2014.<sup>3</sup>
