RESOLUTION AND ORDER

On February 27, 2026, the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board (“Energy Bureau”) issued a Resolution and Order (“February 27 Resolution”) granting FranklinWH Energy Storage Inc. (“FranklinWH”) thirty (30) days to submit pending information and documentation, as required in a previous Resolution and Order issued on the November 20, 2025, in order to evaluate its request for certification as a Demand Response Aggregator, under Regulation 9246¹ and, the applicable provisions of Regulation 8701². The February 27 Resolution listed the corresponding requisites.

On March 28, 2026, FranklinWH filed a document titled *Request for Time Extension regarding Resolution and Order* (“March 28 Motion”), whereby it requested a sixty (60) day extension to comply with February 27 Resolution.

The Energy Bureau **GRANTS** FranklinWH the requested **sixty (60) day extension** to comply with the November 20 and February 27 Resolutions.

The Energy Bureau **WARNS** FranklinWH that failure to comply with this Resolution and Order could result in deeming the request for certification as not filed, in accordance with Regulation 8701.
