**SUBJECT:** Resolution for Motion to Request Extension to Submit Comments on Draft Regulation.


**RESOLUTION**

On March 26, 2026, the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") issued a Resolution and Order ("March 26 Order") informing that it had completed a draft Regulation for the Authorization, Oversight, and Regulation of Municipal Participation in Public Lighting Connected to the Electric Grid ("Draft Regulation") and attached both Spanish and English versions of the Draft Regulation to the March 26 Order. In addition, the Energy Bureau ordered LUMA<sup>1</sup> to submit its comments to the Draft Regulation within ten (10) days.

On April 1, 2026, LUMA submitted a document titled *Motion to Request Extension to Submit Comments on Draft Regulation* ("April 1 Request"), in which LUMA informs it is reviewing the Draft Regulation and intends to submit comments on it, but the ten (10)-day period provided to submit comments is not sufficient for LUMA to effectively yield the thorough comments the regulation merits. LUMA notifies that the legal contractual aspect of the Draft Regulation requires an in-depth evaluation and needs more time to internally coordinate the analysis. Therefore, LUMA requests the Energy Bureau to extend the deadline to submit comments to the Draft Regulation by an additional twenty (20) days, that is, by April 25, 2026.

On April 6, 2026, LUMA filed a document titled *Motion to Submit Preliminary Comments and Reiterate Request for Extension to Submit Detailed Comments on Draft Regulation* ("April 6 Request"), in which LUMA presented some general comments to the Draft Regulation and reiterated its extension request requiring more time to present a complete and detailed comments for the proposed Regulation. Upon review of the April 1 and April 6 Request, the Energy Bureau **DENIES** LUMA's requests. LUMA shall have ample time to file its comments during the formal regulation process as allowed by Act 38-2017.








**CERTIFICATION**
