SUBJECT: 2026-2028 EE and DR Three Year
Plan Procedural Calendar.

RESOLUTION AND ORDER

On March 2, 2026, LUMA¹ filed a *Motion to Submit the Three-Year EE and DR Plan* (“March 2 Motion”), in which LUMA submitted its Three-Year Plan for Energy Efficiency and Demand Response (“TYP”) covering the two-year period from July 1, 2026, through June 30, 2026.

On March 4, 2026, the Energy Bureau issued a Resolution and Order initiating the current proceeding for the review of the 2026-2028 TYP and establishing a procedural calendar. The Energy Bureau scheduled a technical workshop and established deadlines for stakeholders to submit comments and reply comments.

On March 17, 2026, the Energy Bureau held a virtual technical workshop. LUMA gave a presentation on its TYP and answered questions from the Energy Bureau and stakeholders.²

On March 24, 2026, the Energy Bureau issued a Resolution and Order directing LUMA to submit within fourteen (14) calendar days: responses to the Requirements of Information (ROIs) included in Attachment A of the order, a proposal for performance incentive metrics and associated targets for its TYP, and a proposed plan to achieve the statutory goal of 30% savings by 2040 consistent with the EE Regulation (“March 24 Resolution”).

On March 30, 2026, LUMA submitted a *Motion to Request Extension to Comply with Resolution and Order of March 24, 2026* in which LUMA requests an extension until April 20, 2026 to comply with the March 24 Resolution (“March 30 Motion”). LUMA stated that additional time is necessary to ensure that the information is developed with the time necessary to support a complete methodologically sound submission. Additionally, LUMA suggested the Energy Bureau change the deadline for stakeholders to submit comments from April 7, 2026 to April 28, 2026 to allow stakeholders to consider LUMA’s filing in their comments.

On March 31, 2026, the Solar and Energy Storage Association of Puerto Rico (“SESA”) submitted a *Motion in Support of LUMA’s Motion to Request Extension to Comply with Resolution and Order of March 24, 2026* in which it expressed its support for LUMA’s March 30 Motion and requested the Energy Bureau grant LUMA’s request and proposal to extend the deadline for stakeholder comments to April 28, 2026.

The Energy Bureau finds LUMA’s request reasonable. The Energy Bureau **GRANTS** LUMA’s request to extend the deadline to submit its response to the March 24 Resolution and **MODIFIES** the deadline to comply with the requirements of the March 24 Resolution and Order to April 20, 2026.

Additionally, to allow stakeholders to review LUMA’s forthcoming submission and enable greater stakeholder engagement in the TYP process, the Energy Bureau **MODIFIES** the deadlines to submit stakeholder comments and reply comments to April 28, 2026, and May 12, 2026, respectively.

The Energy Bureau acknowledges that on March 7, 2026, the Oficina Independiente de Protección al Consumidor de la Junta Reglamentadora de Servicio Público (“OIPC”) and the Institute of Competitiveness and Economic Sustainability (“ICSE”) submitted comments on

LUMA's TYP. The Energy Bureau invites OIPC and ICSE to submit any additional comments they have following LUMA's April 20 filing.

Stakeholder comments due	April 28, 2026
Reply comments due	May 12, 2026
2026-2028 TYP Implementation	July 1, 2026 - June 30, 2028
