**INFORMATIVE MOTION ON RESPONSES TO REQUESTS FOR INFORMATION IN
COMPLIANCE WITH RESOLUTION AND ORDER OF APRIL 1, 2026**

TO THE HONORABLE PUERTO RICO ENERGY BUREAU:

COME NOW LUMA Energy, LLC (“ManagementCo”), and **LUMA Energy ServCo, LLC** (“ServCo”), (jointly referred to as “LUMA”), and respectfully state and request the following:

1. On April 1, 2026, the Puerto Rico Energy Bureau (“Energy Bureau”) entered a Resolution and Order directing LUMA to file its response to the requests for information included in Attachments A and B of said order, within ten (10) business days (“April 1st Order”). Attachment A contains the requests for information that arose from the Initial Technical Hearing held on March 19, 2026. Meanwhile, Attachment B contains the requests for information regarding potential new or converted power plant options that the Energy Bureau understands the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority (“PREPA”) is considering, based on previous Energy Bureau orders and/or current public policy.

2. The Energy Bureau directed PREPA to provide LUMA with the information necessary for LUMA to respond timely to the requests for information included in Attachment B of the April 1st Order, within five (5) business days.

3. On April 8, 2026, PREPA filed a *Motion Requesting an Extension of Time to Comply with April 1, 2026, Resolution and Order*. PREPA requested a brief extension of time until April 17, 2026, to submit the information to LUMA, as some of it needs to be obtained from AES and the Puerto Rico Public-Private Partnership Authority (“P3A”).

4. On April 16, 2026, LUMA filed a *Motion Submitting Responses to Requests for Information in Compliance with Resolution and Order of April 1, 2026*. Therein, LUMA submitted its responses to the requests for information included in Attachment A. LUMA also explained that, as of that day, it had not received the necessary information from PREPA in order to complete the responses to the requests for information included in Attachment B of the April 1st Order. Therefore, LUMA requested a brief extension of five (5) days after PREPA provides the information pertaining to Attachment B of the April 1st Order, to submit its responses to the requests for information included therein.

5. On April 17, 2026, PREPA filed a *Motion in Compliance with the April 1, 2026, Resolution and Order and Memorandum of Law in Support of Request for Confidential Treatment*. PREPA submitted its responses to the requests for information in Attachment B of the April 1st Order.

6. In view of the above, LUMA hereby informs that, considering that PREPA has already provided responses to the requests for information in Attachment B of the April 1st Order to the Energy Bureau, there is no need for LUMA to reproduce those responses. PREPA’s responses fully address the requests for information posed by the Energy Bureau in Attachment B of the April 1st Order. Thus, the Energy Bureau should deem LUMA to have complied with the April 1st Order.

WHEREFORE, LUMA respectfully requests that the Energy Bureau **take notice** of the aforementioned; **accept** PREPA's responses to the requests for information included in Attachment B of the April 1st Order; and **deem** LUMA to have complied with the April 1st Order.
