RESOLUTION AND ORDER

On March 5, 2026, the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") issued a Resolution and Order ("March 5 Resolution") granting NFE POWER PR, LLC ("NFE Power") thirty (30) days to submit its financial statements for FY 2024, as requested.


On April 7, 2026, NFE Power filed a document titled *Motion in Compliance with Resolution and Order* ("April 7 Motion") submitting its FY2024 Financial Statements and requesting confidential treatment and designation. NFE Power submitted a redacted version of the financial statements in compliance with: (i) Section 6.15 of Act 57-2014¹; (ii) Section 1.15 of Regulation 8701²; and (iii) *In Re: Policy on Management of Confidential Information in Procedures before the Commission*, Case No.: CEPR-MI-2016-0009, Resolution and Order issued on August 31, 2016 ("Confidential Treatment Resolution").

The Energy Bureau **GRANTS** confidential treatment to the financial statements attached to the April 7 Motion.


The Energy Bureau **DETERMINES** NFE Power complied with the March 5 Resolution. Nonetheless, since a discrepancy between the information provided on the gross revenue report submitted on March 4, 2025 (\$1,136,454.40) and the 2024 financial statements submitted through the April 7 Motion (\$1,357,207) has been identified, in accordance with Section 4.02(H), the Energy Bureau **ORDERS** NFE Power to, within **twenty (20) days**, explain such discrepancy.

The Energy Bureau **WARNS** NFE Power that in accordance with Art. 6.36 of Act 57-2014, noncompliance with this Resolution and Order may carry the imposition of fines.


