**RESOLUTION AND ORDER**

On February 13, 2026, Sol-Ark Services LLC ("Sol-Ark") filed before the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") a Request for Certification of Demand Response Aggregator<sup>1</sup>, ("February 13 Submission") including several forms and documents.

On March 10, 2026, the Energy Bureau issued a Resolution and Order ("March 10 Resolution") granting Sol-Ark thirty (30) days to comply with certain requirements under Article 3, Section 6.01 and Section 6.03 of Regulation 9246.

On April 1, 2026, Sol-Ark filed a document titled *Motion in Compliance with Resolution and Order* ("April 1 Motion") regarding its compliance with the information requested in the March 10 Resolution.

On April 9, 2026, Sol-Ark filed a document titled *Privacy Policy* ("April 9 Document").

Upon reviewing April 1 Motion and April 9 Document, the Energy Bureau **CERTIFIES** Sol-Ark's as a Demand Response Aggregator under the special circumstances of the Transition Period Plan ("TPP") and LUMA's Emergency Demand Response Program.

Certification Expiration Date: **June 30, 2028**.<sup>2</sup>

Certification can be renewed upon Sol-Ark's request. Renewal requests shall be filed at least **thirty (30) days** before the Expiration Date (June 30, 2028).

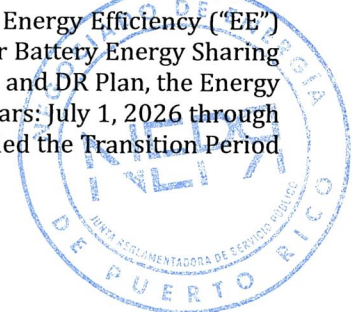
The Energy Bureau **ORDERS** the Clerk's Office to include Sol-Ark in the List of Certified Demand Response Aggregators at the Energy Bureau's website, including Sol-Ark's contact information, as required by Section 2.02(C) of Regulation 9246.

As a result of the directive issued through the October 24 Resolution, **starting on 2027**, DR Aggregators shall begin to report gross revenues and submit financial statements. Specifically, DR Aggregators shall submit with the corresponding information of Fiscal Year 2026: (i) Gross Revenue Report as required by Section 4.02(A) of Regulation 8701; and (ii) Financial Statements (audited or compiled according to the amount of gross revenue) as required in Section 4.02(E) and (F) of Regulation 8701.

Considering the foregoing, the Energy Bureau **ORDERS** Sol-Ark to submit during 2027 its: (i) Gross Revenue Report as required by Section 4.02(A) of Regulation 8701; and (ii) Financial

Additionally, the Energy Bureau extended the Transition Period Plan ("TPP") until June 30, 2026.



Statements as required in Section 4.02(E) and (F) of Regulation 8701, **with the corresponding 2026 information, and on the filing dates established in these provisions.**


The Energy Bureau **REMINDS** Sol-Ark that, on a yearly basis, it must submit a report with a description of the complete activities during the year, as a DR Aggregator, as required by Section 5.01(A) of Regulation 9246.

The Energy Bureau **WARNS** Sol-Ark that failure to comply with this Resolution and Order will result in the imposition of fines in accordance with Section 6.36 of Act 57-2014.<sup>3</sup>




