RESOLUTION AND ORDER

On March 20, 2026, the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") issued an Order ("March 20 Order") granting the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority ("PREPA") ten (10) days to show cause as to why the Energy Bureau should not impose an administrative fine of \$10,000 pursuant to Article 6.36 of Act 57-2014¹, for failure to comply with the Energy Bureau's regulatory requirement of Section 4.02 of Regulation 8701² of filing its annual Gross Revenue Report and ordered it to submit its Gross Revenue Report within the same timeframe.


On April 7, 2026, PREPA filed a document titled *Informative Motion Regarding the 2025 Gross Revenue Report* ("April 7 Motion") reporting that the Gross Revenue Report would be submitted upon the revision and approval of its Governing Board at their next meeting at the end of April.


Upon reviewing the April 7 Motion, the Energy Bureau **TAKES NOTICE** of the information provided and **GRANTS PREPA thirty (30) days** from the notification of this Resolution and Order to file its Gross Revenue Report. Once PREPA complies with the March 20 Order, the Energy Bureau shall decide on the imposition of the fine.

The Energy Bureau **WARNS** PREPA that in accordance with Art. 6.36 of Act 57-2014, noncompliance with this Resolution and Order may carry the imposition of fines.

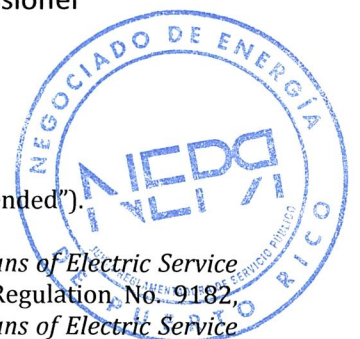


