SUBJECT: Resolution and Order pertaining to *Motion Requesting Additional Time to File Status Update*, filed by Global Power Solutions (PR) LLC.


RESOLUTION AND ORDER

On January 29, 2026, the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board (“Energy Bureau”) issued a Resolution and Order granting Global Power Solutions (PR) LLC (“Global Power”) a ninety (90) day extension to provide the next status update regarding its participation in an emergency temporary power generation process for the procurement of 800 MW.


On April 20, 2026, Global Power filed a document titled *Motion Requesting Additional Time to File Status Update* (“April 20 Motion”) reporting, among other things, that the Agreement has not been executed, and that they remain prepared to move forward and is standing by for direction and further action by the relevant public entities.¹ Global requested an additional ninety (90) day extension to file the subsequent status update regarding execution of the agreement and compliance with the corresponding documentation.

The Energy Bureau **TAKES NOTICE** of the information presented by Global Power in the April 20 Motion and **GRANTS** it the requested **ninety (90) day extension** to provide the next status update. Nevertheless, the Energy Bureau **ORDERS** Global Power to report any relevant information on the status of the Agreement that may arise during the ninety (90) day period.
