SUBJECT: Workshop Schedule.

RESOLUTION AND ORDER

On April 10, 2026, the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board (“Energy Bureau”), issued a regulatory order re-summing the Community Solar Regulatory Framework proceeding (“April 10 Order”).

The April 10 Order included a series of guidance questions and laid out a tentative schedule that initially invited all stakeholders (including LUMA¹), on the first week, to indicate if any of the guidance questions needed clarification, and if there were any suggested additions to said questions. The tentative schedule called for stakeholders to answer the questions by week 6, before the workshop is conducted.

Stakeholders largely responded to the first week’s deadline by providing answers to the questions as opposed to just comments on the questions posed. There were no specific recommendations on, or additional questions or modifications to the questions posed by the Energy Bureau. LUMA did not file answers or comments on the questions.


The tentative schedule called for a workshop to be held during week 7 (*i.e.*, week of May 29), after stakeholders had the opportunity to reply to a revised set of questions. Given that parties have already largely responded to the questions, the Energy Bureau **DETERMINES** to schedule the workshop following the questions, as posed, in the April 10 Order. The Workshop will be held on **Tuesday, June 9, 2026 at 10:00 am in the Energy Bureau’s Hearing Room on the 8th floor of the World Plaza Bldg. in Hato Rey, Puerto Rico.** The Energy Bureau invites all stakeholders to inform the Bureau’s Clerk (by email at secretaria@jrsp.pr.gov) of their intent to participate and if they would like time on the agenda to make a short presentation on any of the questions.


The Energy Bureau **ORDERS** LUMA to respond to the original guidance questions, included in the April 10 Order, **on or before May 29, 2026**, and to prepare a presentation for the Workshop scheduled for **June 9, 2026 at 10:00 am**. Said presentation shall not be limited by the questions posed in the April 10 Order and include the current state of estimation of avoided costs, as well as their proposed method of compensating the Community Solar projects for excess power injected into the grid.
