IN RE: ACCELERATED EVALUATION OF RENEWABLE ENERGY AND ENERGY STORAGE PROJECT PROPOSALS TO SECURE FEDERAL INVESTMENT TAX CREDITS (ITCs)

SUBJECT: Confirmation that PREPA submitted all proposals to the Energy Bureau under the Governor's Executive Order OE-2025-047.

RESOLUTION AND ORDER

On September 22, 2025 the Governor of Puerto Rico, Hon. Jennifer A. González Colón, issued Executive Order OE-2025-047 ("Executive Order") which amended and expanded the Puerto Rico energy emergency and authorized extraordinary measures to accelerate the evaluation and approval of renewable energy and storage projects qualifying for federal investment tax credits ("ITCs") under Public Law 119-21, also known as the One Big Beautiful Bill Act ("OBBBA"). On September 26, 2025, the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") issued a Resolution and Order ("September 26 Resolution") through which it provided the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority ("PREPA") with guidelines for implementing the accelerated acquisition of renewable resources under Executive Order.

Following several procedural steps, on November 13, 2025, PREPA submitted to the Energy Bureau a filing titled *Moción en Cumplimiento de Resolución y Orden de 26 de septiembre de 2025 y Memorando en Apoyo a Solicitud de Confidencialidad* ("November 13 Motion"), in which PREPA states it has complied with the requirements established in the September 26 Resolution. Through this motion, PREPA submitted a document titled *Evaluation Report - Request for Proposal (RFP) Power Advocate Event 237366*, identified as *Anejo 1*, which contains PREPA's analysis of the proposals received and its resulting recommendations. PREPA also includes Attachments A-H to Anejo 1, which consist of PREPA's individual evaluation summaries for each proposal, with the proponent names redacted under the Energy Bureau's directives.

On November 27, 2025, the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board (Energy Bureau") issued a Resolution and Order ("November 27 Order") in which it ordered PREPA to submit all documentation generated, received, transmitted, or relied upon as part of the accelerated acquisition of renewable resources process conducted under the Executive Order and the September 26 Resolution. The required production shall include, without limitation: all communications, notifications, or correspondence issued by PREPA or received by PREPA from any proponent; all proposals submitted by proponents; and all materials or communications related to PREPA's evaluation and review of such proposals.

On December 5, 2025, PREPA complied with the November 27 Order and filed the proposal of eight proponents.


On May 6, 2026, the Energy Bureau issued a Resolution and Order requesting PREPA to confirm that the eight (8) proposals filed with the December 5 Compliance Motion constitute the entirety of all proposals received in this proceeding and to the extent any additional proposals were received to submit such proposals within a seven (7)-day period.

To assure that the Energy Bureau has a complete file of all the documents filed by all the proponents in this proceeding, the Energy Bureau **ORDERS** PREPA to file within the same seven (7) days established on the May 6 Order, **ALL** documentation exchange between PREPA and the proponents since the opening of the RFP process through the present date, including but not limited to communications, price adjustments, contract amendment

requests and any other related documentation. This submission shall also include the proposals filed with the December 5 Compliance Motion.

The Energy Bureau **WARNS** PREPA that failure to comply with this Resolution and Order will result in the imposition of fines under Section 6.36 of Act 57-2014.


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
