**RESOLUTION AND ORDER**

On April 8, 2026, the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") issued a Resolution and Order ("April 8 Resolution") granting NFE POWER PR, LLC ("NFE POWER") twenty (20) days to submit the microgrid reports required by Section 3.04(B) of Regulation 9028.<sup>1</sup>

On April 23, 2026, the Energy Bureau issued a Resolution and Order ("April 23 Resolution") granting NFE POWER twenty (20) days to explain the discrepancy between the information provided in its *Gross Revenue Report* (Form NEPR-B05) for FY 2024 and the financial statements submitted for the same fiscal year.

On April 30, 2026, NFE POWER filed a document titled *Informative Motion and Request for Extension of Time* ("April 30 Motion") reporting that it was compiling the necessary information to submit its microgrid reports and requesting a ten (10) day extension to submit the microgrids reports required by the Energy Bureau through the April 8 Resolution. In the April 30 Motion, NFE POWER also reported that it was still reviewing the corresponding information to explain the discrepancy between its Gross Revenue Report and its financial statements for FY 2024, as required in the April 23 Resolution. NFE POWER further informed that, despite efforts, the compiled FY 2025 financial statements were not finalized and requested until the end of September 2026 to file them.

Upon reviewing the April 30 Motion, the Energy Bureau **GRANTS** NFE POWER: (i) **ten (10) days** to submit the microgrid reports required in the April 8 Resolution, as requested; (ii) **ten (10) days** to explain the discrepancy between its Gross Revenue Report and the financial statements for FY 2024, as required in the April 23 Resolution; and (iii) **until September 30, 2026** to submit its FY 2025 financial statements, as requested.

The Energy Bureau **WARNS** NFE POWER, that, in accordance with Art. 6.36 of Act 57-2014<sup>2</sup> non-compliance with this Resolution and Order; regulations and/or applicable laws may carry the imposition of fines and administrative sanctions.







