RESOLUTION AND ORDER


On April 23, 2026, Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board (“Energy Bureau”) granted ENFIN ENERGY CORP. (“EnFin”) twenty (20) days: (i) to submit evidence of publication of the Customer Complaint Procedure, as required by Section 6.03 of Regulation 9246¹; (ii) to clarify its Privacy Policy²; and (iii) to clarify what is the 2025 gross revenue amount reported in its Financial Statements (“April 23 Resolution”).

On May 14, 2026, EnFin filed a document titled *Urgent Motion Requesting Short Extension of Time* (“May 14 Motion”) requesting until May 20, 2026, to comply with the April 23 Resolution.


The Energy Bureau **GRANTS** EnFin **until May 20, 2026**, to comply with the April 23 Resolution, as requested.

The Energy Bureau **WARNS** EnFin that failure to comply with this Resolution and Order will result in the imposition of fines in accordance with Section 6.36 of Act 57-2014³.



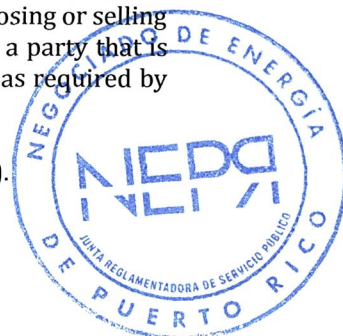
