**RESOLUTION AND ORDER**

On April 8, 2026, the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board (“Energy Bureau”) issued a Resolution and Order (“April 8 Resolution”) granting FranklinWH Energy Storage Inc. (“FranklinWH”) a sixty (60) day extension to submit pending information and documentation in order to evaluate its request for certification as a Demand Response Aggregator, under Regulation 9246.<sup>1</sup>

On May 5, 2026, FranklinWH submitted certain information in compliance with Section 2.02 of Regulation 9246.

On May 13, 2026, FranklinWH filed a document titled *Request for Time Extension regarding Resolution and Order* (“May 13 Motion”) reporting its efforts to fulfill the remaining technical and documentary requirements and requesting a thirty (30) day extension to comply with April 8 Resolution.

The Energy Bureau **GRANTS** FranklinWH the requested **thirty (30) day extension**.

The Energy Bureau **WARNS** FranklinWH that failure to comply with this Resolution and Order may result in deeming the request for certification as not filed, in accordance with Regulation 8701.<sup>2</sup>


