**RESOLUTION AND ORDER**


On May 15, 2026, the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board (“Energy Bureau”) issued an Order to Show Cause (“May 15 Order”)<sup>1</sup> ordering ENFIN ENERGY CORP. (“EnFin”) to show cause within ten (10) days as to why the Energy Bureau should not impose an administrative fine of \$10,000 pursuant to Article 6.36 of Act 57-2014<sup>2</sup> for failure to comply with the Energy Bureau's regulatory requirements, to file its Operational Report as required by Section 2.02 of Regulation 8701<sup>3</sup>.


On May 28, 2026, EnFin filed a document titled *Motion in Compliance with Order to Show Cause and Request for Short Extension to Submit Operational Report* (“May 28 Motion”) reporting that it had been working in preparing the necessary information, but it has not yet been able to finalize its Operational Report. EnFin requests until June 3, 2026, to submit its Operational Report.


The Energy Bureau **GRANTS** EnFin **until June 3, 2026**, to file its Operational Report.

The Energy Bureau **WARNS** EnFin that failure to comply with this Resolution and Order will result in the imposition of fines in accordance with Section 6.36 of Act 57-2014.
