SUBJECT: Resolution and Order regarding *Motion in Compliance with May 1, 2026, Resolution and Order and to Request Reconsideration of Confidential Treatment, Determination*, filed by Xcala Strategies, LLC.

RESOLUTION AND ORDER

On May 1, 2026, the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") issued a Resolution and Order ("May 1 Resolution") that: (i) certified Xcala Strategies, LLC ("Xcala") as an Electric Service Company under Regulation 8701¹; (ii) denied confidential treatment to the April 6 Submission, except as specifically authorized therein, and (iii) granted ten (10) days to submit an updated version of the redacted version of the April 6 Submission, in accordance with the Energy Bureau's confidentiality determination.

On May 8, 2026, Xcala filed a document titled *Motion in Compliance with May 1, 2026, Resolution and Order and to Request Reconsideration of Confidential Treatment Determination* ("May 8 Motion") reporting:

A. Complying with the confidentiality designation through the following actions:

1. Requesting that the following documents be reclassified as public documents:
 - a. *Operational Report Electric Power Companies* (Form NEPR-B03) (Attachment II-2).
 - b. Supplemental Attachment II-1 of the *Operational Report Electric Power Companies* (Form NEPR-B03) - Xcala's Board Members and Shareholders.
 - c. Supplemental Attachment II-4 of the *Operational Report Electric Power Companies* (Form NEPR-B03) - Permits, authorizations, and endorsements.

 2. Requesting that the following documents that were submitted in a redacted version be removed from the record:
 - a. *Operational Report Electric Power Companies* (Form NEPR-B03) (Attachment II-2).
 - b. Supplemental Attachment II-1 of the *Operational Report Electric Power Companies* (Form NEPR-B03) - Xcala's Board Members and Shareholders.
 - c. Supplemental Attachment II-4 of the *Operational Report Electric Power Companies* (Form NEPR-B03) - Permits, authorizations, and endorsements.

 3. Submitting an updated version of the following redacted documents:
 - a. Updated redacted version of *Request for Certification Electric Power Companies* (Form NEPR-B04) - Keeping redacted only the information of: (i) aggregated capacity of the company's generation (MW); and (ii) energy sources used in installations.
 - b. Updated redacted version of *Personal Information Electric Power Companies* (Form NEPR-B01) - Keeping redacted only the telephone number of the agent resident of the company.

B. Requesting reconsideration regarding the following matters and submitting an updated redacted version:

1. Requesting that the confidential treatment granted to the information regarding projected capital investments included in Annex 3 of Supplemental Attachment II-2 of the *Operational Report Electric Power Companies* (Form NEPR-B03) be granted to the same information in Annex 5 of Supplemental Attachment II-3 of Form NEPR-B03.²
2. Requesting that the information regarding rate and charges denied confidential treatment in the May 1 Resolution be now treated as confidential. To sustain this request Xcala is submitting an updated redacted version of Attachment II-2 of the *Operational Report Electric Power Companies* (Form NEPR-B03) where only Annex 2, with the rate and charges information, remains confidential.

Jm Section 6.15(a) of Act 57-2014³ establishes that one of the considerations for the appropriate evaluation by the Energy Bureau, is when a confidentiality treatment and designation is requested and when it believes such information should be protected, to grant such protection in a manner that **least affects the public interest, transparency, and the rights of the parties** involved in the administrative procedure in which the allegedly confidential document is submitted.

JAB Xcala's request for reconsideration of the confidentiality ruling is based on Act 80-2011⁴. Specifically, regarding Annex 2 of Attachment II-2 Xcala argued:

1. That is an estimated rate structure.
2. The final rate structure will depend on the future energy contracts with its clients.
3. The final uniform rate has not been determined yet.
4. Since the range is preliminary, making it public could harm future negotiations with potential customers.
5. Is not publicly available.
6. Is of economic value to Xcala whose disclosure may affect its competitiveness.

am The Energy Bureau **CLARIFIES** that the confidentiality designation granted in the May 1 Resolution to the information regarding projected capital investments included in Annex 3 of Supplemental Attachment II-2 of the *Operational Report Electric Power Companies* (Form NEPR-B03) by extension applies to the same information in Annex 5 of Supplemental Attachment II-3 of Form NEPR-B03.

The Energy Bureau **GRANTS** Xcala's confidentiality request only as it pertains to the information on rate and charges in Annex 2 of Attachment II-2 and **REMINDS** Xcala that once the rate structure is established it must be submitted to the Energy Bureau for its review and approval. The Energy Bureau **DENIES** the remaining requests as they does not meet the criteria for confidential designation.


