Responses to the April 10, 2026 Questions

**MOTION TO SUBMIT RESPONSES TO THE APRIL 10, 2026 QUESTIONS
TO THE HONORABLE PUERTO RICO ENERGY BUREAU:**

COME NOW, LUMA ENERGY, LLC as Management Co., and **LUMA ENERGY SERVCO, LLC** (collectively, "LUMA"), through the respective undersigned legal counsel and respectfully state and submit the following:

1. On April 10, 2026, the Puerto Rico Energy Bureau (the "Energy Bureau") issued a Resolution (the "April 10 Resolution") reinitiating a proceeding to establish the regulatory framework that will guide the development of regulations for community solar projects. The Bureau explained that it intends to gather information and begin discussions, with the goal of producing a draft report and an outline of proposed regulations to ultimately support a formal rulemaking process.

2. In the April 10 Resolution, the Bureau invited comments and feedback in response to the questions set forth in Attachment A, to be submitted on or before April 17, 2026. The Bureau also welcomed additional information and requests for clarification, as appropriate.

3. On April 17, 2026, LUMA submitted a document titled Notice of Intent to Participate and Notice Regarding April 10, 2026 Invitation for Comments, stating that, while it recognizes the importance of the above-captioned proceedings, it was not in a position to provide meaningful and

complete responses to the questions set forth in Attachment A of the April 10 Resolution within the short timeframe (five business days) provided for the submission of responses and comments.

4. On May 6, 2026, the Energy Bureau issued a Resolution and Order (the “May 6 Order”) establishing a schedule for a workshop to be held on June 9, 2026. The Energy Bureau also directed LUMA to respond to the original guidance questions included in the April 10 Resolution on or before May 29, 2026. In addition, the May 6 Order requires LUMA to submit a presentation for the Workshop; however, it does not establish a deadline for the submission of such presentation.

5. In compliance with the May 6 Order, LUMA hereby submits its nonbinding responses to the questions set forth in the April 10 Resolution. *See Annex A.* LUMA further informs that, also in compliance with the Order, it will prepare and submit a presentation for the June 9, 2026 Workshop.

WHEREFORE, LUMA respectfully requests that this Energy Bureau take notice of the foregoing and find LUMA in compliance with the April 10 Order.
