**MOTION REQUESTING EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE JOINT STATUS
SUBMISSION REGARDING PROPONENT NO. 7**

TO THE HONORABLE PUERTO RICO ENERGY BUREAU:

COMES NOW the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority (“PREPA”), through its counsel, and respectfully submits and prays as follows:

1. On May 20, 2026, the Puerto Rico Energy Bureau (“Energy Bureau”) issued a Resolution and Order directing, among other things, PREPA and Proponent No. 7 to meet and confer within ten (10) days to evaluate and clarify issues concerning property rights, site control, and the status of permits and authorizations related to the proposed project. The Energy Bureau further ordered PREPA and Proponent No. 7 to jointly submit a status filing informing whether sufficient clarification or agreement had been reached to permit the continuation of the contract evaluation and negotiation process.

2. In compliance with the Resolution and Order, representatives of PREPA and Proponent No. 7 held a virtual meeting on May 22, 2026, during which the parties discussed the matters identified by the Energy Bureau and reviewed the information and documentation relevant to the issues raised in the Resolution and Order.

3. Following such meeting, PREPA and Proponent No. 7 have continued evaluating the issues identified by the Energy Bureau and discussing the contents of the joint status submission, as well as the supporting documentation to be included therewith.

4. The parties are making substantial progress toward finalizing their joint submission. However, additional time is necessary to complete their review of the supporting materials and ensure that the filing fully and accurately addresses the matters identified by the Energy Bureau.

5. Accordingly, PREPA respectfully requests that the Energy Bureau grant the parties until Wednesday, June 3, 2026, to file the joint status submission required by the Resolution and Order.

6. The requested extension is modest, is sought in good faith, and will facilitate the submission of a complete and informative filing for the Energy Bureau's consideration. No party will be prejudiced by the requested extension.

WHEREFORE, PREPA respectfully requests that the Energy Bureau grant the parties until June 3, 2026, to file the joint status submission regarding Proponent No. 7
