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**MOTION TO SUBMIT FEDERAL FUNDING AND GRID MODERNIZATION REPORT
FOR JUNE 2026**

TO THE HONORABLE PUERTO RICO ENERGY BUREAU:

COMES NOW the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority ("PREPA"), through its counsel, and respectfully submits and prays as follows:

1. On June 25, 2023, the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("PREB") issued a Resolution and Order modifying and, as such, approving the Consolidated Annual Budgets for Fiscal Year 2024 (hereinafter, the "June 25th Resolution").

2. Additionally, the PREB directed PREPA to present the Implementation of the Grid Modernization Plan on a bi-monthly basis (hereinafter, the "Grid Modernization Report"). Pursuant to the June 25th Resolution, the Grid Modernization Report shall include a comprehensive overview of the primary investment areas and projects being considered by PREPA to ensure the provision of dependable and resilient electric service, together with the current progress of project milestones.

3. PREPA was also ordered to submit monthly reports detailing federal funding activity for hydro facilities, including progress on the submission and advancement of Project Worksheets ("PWs") and Scopes of Work ("SOWs"), by hydro/dam site, the cumulative amount of federal funding applied for, the incremental amount of federal funding applied for during the reporting period, and both the cumulative and monthly amount of federal funding received.

4. On November 13, 2023, the PREB issued a Resolution and Order authorizing, among other things, a monthly cadence for the Grid Modernization Implementation Report.

5. Moreover, on June 26, 2024, the PREB issued a Resolution and Order regarding the FY 2025 Budget review. The PREB determined that the FY 2025 Budgets, as modified by the Resolution and Order, comply with Act 57-2014 and the 2017 Rate Order. The PREB further stated that "[a]ll existing Reporting Requirements remain in full force and effect."

6. In compliance with PREB's reporting requirements, PREPA hereby submits, as Exhibit I, the Federal Funding and Grid Modernization Report for June 2026.

WHEREFORE, PREPA respectfully requests that the Energy Bureau take NOTICE of this filing and deems PREPA in compliance with the applicable reporting requirements.
