SUBJECT: Motion for Extension of Time to Submit an Application to FEMA for Section 406 Hazard Mitigation Funding for the TAShelix Mobile Platform Implementation Project.

**MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO FEMA
FOR SECTION 406 HAZARD MITIGATION FUNDING FOR THE TASHLIX
MOBILE PLATFORM IMPLEMENTATION PROJECT**

TO THE HONORABLE PUERTO RICO ENERGY BUREAU:

COME NOW LUMA Energy, LLC (“ManagementCo”), and LUMA Energy ServCo, LLC (“ServCo”), (jointly “LUMA”), and respectfully state and request the following:

1. On April 15, 2026, the Honorable Puerto Rico Energy Bureau (“Energy Bureau”) issued a *Final Resolution and Order on Electricity Rates* (“Final Rate Order”) in the matter of *In Re: Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority Rate Review*, case no. NEPR-AP-2023-0003 (“Rate Case Proceeding”). The Final Rate Order includes multiple orders, including for LUMA to submit “an application to FEMA for Section 406 Hazard Mitigation funding for the TASHelix Mobile Platform Implementation [project] within 90 days of this Order.” Final Rate Order, Chapter III, p. 136.

2. LUMA respectfully informs that it is working to submit an application to the Federal Emergency Management Agency (“FEMA”) for Section 406 Hazard Mitigation funding for the TASHelix Mobile Platform project in compliance with the Final Rate Order. However, despite its best efforts, and for the reasons discussed below, LUMA respectfully informs that it

will not be able to submit the application to FEMA for Section 406 Hazard Mitigation funding for the TAShelix Mobile Platform project by the July 14, 2026, deadline.

3. The rationale for seeking this extension is twofold. First, in compliance with the Final Rate Order, LUMA submitted on May 14, 2026, in the *In Re: Review of the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority's 10-Year Infrastructure Plan-December 2020*, Case No. NEPR-MI-2021-0002 (“Federal Funding Docket”), a proposed Attachment A that included the TAShelix Mobile Platform project to be formulated under the FEMA FAAS process to determine eligibility, and sought the Energy Bureau’s approval.¹ On June 18, 2026, the Energy Bureau issued a *Resolution and Order* in the Federal Funding Docket whereby, among other things, it approved LUMA’s proposed Attachment A. Only at that point was there complete clarity regarding the funding source and the pathway for FEMA activation of the TAShelix Mobile Platform project.

4. Second, LUMA has been conducting internal meetings to determine the most effective project formulation to enhance FEMA eligibility. These discussions have yielded a range of options and strategies. Furthermore, on June 22, 2026, LUMA consulted with the Central Office for Reconstruction, Recovery and Resiliency (“COR3”) to gather input and recommendations on the project’s formulation. COR3’s feedback is now being incorporated as LUMA compiles all relevant information to ensure a well-informed decision. The goal is to structure the project to maximize eligibility for FEMA funding while minimizing risks to the Section 428 funding allocation. LUMA plans to continue collaborating with COR3 and other stakeholders to ensure that everyone remains aligned throughout the project formulation process.

5. The timing of the Energy Bureau approval of LUMA’s proposed Attachment A coupled with the need for project formulation and coordination with COR3, has made the

submission to FEMA of the TAShelix Mobile Platform impracticable within 90 days of the Final Rate Order. As such, LUMA requires an extension of time, until October 14, 2026, to submit the application to FEMA for Section 406 Hazard Mitigation funding.

6. LUMA is committed to complying with the Final Rate Order to submit an application to FEMA for Section 406 Hazard Mitigation funding for the TAShelix Mobile Platform project. Granting an extension until October 14, 2026, will provide LUMA with the necessary timeframe to comprehensively develop the TAShelix Mobile Platform project formulation to enhance FEMA eligibility.

7. LUMA submits this request in good faith, without intending to cause undue delay, and for the purpose of treating the aforementioned project to FEMA with the time and attention it deserves.

WHEREFORE, LUMA respectfully requests that the Energy Bureau **take notice** of the foregoing, **grant** this *Motion for Extension of Time to Submit an Application to FEMA for Section 406 Hazard Mitigation Funding for the TAShelix Mobile Platform Implementation Project*, and accordingly **extend** the deadline to submit the application to FEMA until September 14, 2026.
