SUBJECT: Resolution and Order for Motion to Inform Completion of Vega Baja Decommissioning Plan and to Request Relief from Quarterly Reporting Requirement.

RESOLUTION AND ORDER

I. Relevant Background

On April 17, 2024, GENERA PR LLC ("Genera") submitted a letter to the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") regarding the Vega Baja Decommissioning Plan ("April 17 Letter"). Enclosed with the April 17 Letter Genera included a document titled *Vega Baja Proposed Decommissioning Plan* ("Preliminary Draft Plan"), prepared by Sargent & Lundy, Genera's consultant. In the April 17 Letter, Genera requested the Energy Bureau's "review" and "input" on the Preliminary Draft Plan.

On October 31, 2024, the Energy Bureau issued a Resolution and Order ("October 31 Order"), in which the Energy Bureau approved Genera's Proposed Decommissioning Plan, subject to specific conditions outlined in the October 31 Order, including submitting an updated version of the Proposed Demolition Plan.

On December 18, 2024, Genera filed a document titled *Motion to Submit the Revised Updated Decommissioning Plan* ("December 18 Motion"), in which Genera submitted a revised Updated Decommissioning Plan incorporating all mandated changes ordered by the Energy Bureau.

On December 19, 2024, the Energy Bureau issued a Resolution and Order ("December 19 Order"), through which it determined that the Updated Decommissioning Plan dated December 16, 2026, complies with the requirements set forth by the Energy Bureau.

On July 29, 2025, Genera filed a document titled *Motion to Submit Quarterly Report for the Vega Baja Decommissioning Plan* ("July 29 Motion"). Through the July 29 Motion, Genera submitted the "Quarterly Progress Report: Genera PR Vega Baja Power Plant" which informed that demolition activities were completed on June 11, 2025, final restoration was completed on June 21, 2025, and subcontractors demobilized from the site on June 26, 2025. On November 14, 2025, Genera filed a document titled *Motion to Inform Completion of Vega Baja Decommissioning Plan and to Request Relief from Quarterly Reporting Requirement* ("November 14 Motion"), in which Genera request the Energy Bureau to grant relief from the quarterly reporting requirement set forth in Section 11.1 of the Decommissioning Plan.

II. Conclusion




