SUBJECT: Extension of time to Submit the
List of All Inactive Projects with Updated
Cost Estimate in Compliance with the June
18, 2026, Resolution and Order.

RESOLUTION AND ORDER

On June 18, 2026, the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") issued a Resolution and Order ("June 18 Resolution") addressing LUMA Energy, LLC and LUMA Energy ServCo, LLC's (jointly, "LUMA") proposed adjustments to the Consolidated FEMA Accelerated Award Strategy ("FAAST") Project List. Among other determinations, the Energy Bureau approved Modified Attachment A and ordered LUMA to submit, on or before July 15, 2026, an informative motion containing specified project, funding, versioning, reconciliation, and scheduling information as detailed in the June 18 Resolution.

The June 18 Resolution required LUMA to submit a list of all inactive projects with updated cost estimates, including Section 428 costs, Section 406 costs, Global Project Worksheet allocations, expected total costs, incurred costs, and a ranking of projects in order of priority ("List of Inactive Projects"). The required list must include, at a minimum, the projects not approved at that time under Attachments B and C, as well as any other pending project identified for potential future activation or reactivation.

On July 10, 2026, LUMA filed a *Motion for Extension of Time to Submit the List of All Inactive Projects with Updated Cost Estimates in Compliance with the June 18, 2026, Resolution and Order* ("July 10 Motion"). LUMA states that the List of Inactive Projects will encompass more than three hundred (300) transmission and distribution projects and will require coordination among multiple stakeholders and a comprehensive assessment of project estimates, allocations, costs, and prioritization rankings.

LUMA therefore requests an extension until August 17, 2026, to submit the List of Inactive Projects. On July 15, 2026, LUMA filed a document titled *Submittal of LUMA's Report in Partial Compliance with the June 18, 2026, Resolution and Order* in which LUMA alleges complies with the remaining information required by the June 18 Resolution.

Upon review of the July 10 Motion, the Energy Bureau determines that LUMA has demonstrated good cause for the requested extension. Accordingly, the Energy Bureau **GRANTS** LUMA's request for an extension until **August 17, 2026**, solely for the submission of the List of Inactive Projects required by the June 18 Resolution.

All other directives, requirements, and deadlines established in the June 18 Resolution remain unchanged and in full force and effect.

The Energy Bureau **WARNS** LUMA that, in accordance with Article 6.36 of Act 57-2014:¹

- i. Noncompliance with this Resolution and Order, applicable regulations, or laws may carry the imposition of fines and administrative sanctions of up to one hundred twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) per day; and
- ii. In the event of recurrent violations or continued non-compliance, the penalty shall increase to no less than fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000)

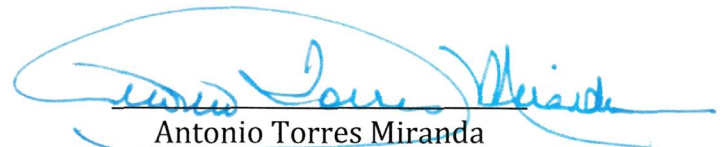


and up to two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) per violation, at the discretion of the Energy Bureau.
