the July 15th Resolution and Order and
Reconsideration of the Reporting Template
for Vegetation Management Progress
Reports.

RESOLUTION AND ORDER

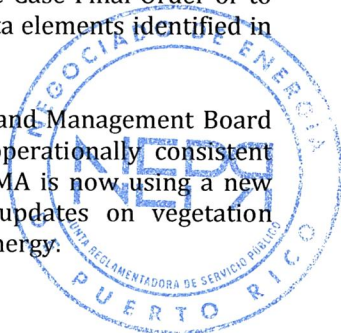
On August 8, 2024, the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") issued a Resolution and Order in the docket In Re: Review of LUMA's Initial Budgets, Case No. NEPR-MI-2021-0004 ("2024 Order"), ordering LUMA Energy, LLC, and LUMA Energy ServCo, LLC, (jointly referred to as "LUMA") to utilize the template in Attachment A for the quarterly Vegetation Management reporting, and to file said reports in the present case within forty five (45) days after the end of each quarter, beginning with the fourth quarter of Fiscal Year 2024 and continuing until further notice.

After several procedural events¹, on July 15, 2026, the Energy Bureau issued a Resolution and Order ("July 15 Resolution") relieving LUMA of the requirements imposed by the 2024 Order. The Energy Bureau stated that the quarterly template adopted in the 2024 Order was superseded by the amended templates issued as Attachment A of the May 13 Order and the July 15th Order; determined that all vegetation reports shall be filed quarterly, not monthly; and clarified that the quarterly reporting requirements, established through the May 13 Order, would begin with the work performed in June 2026. The Energy Bureau also established that the due date for each quarterly report would be the first day of the second month following the end of the reporting quarter. The first quarterly report is due on November 1, 2026.

On August 4, 2026, LUMA filed a document titled *Motion Seeking Clarification of The July 15th Resolution and Order and Reconsideration of The Reporting Template and Deadline For Vegetation Management Progress Reports* ("Motion"). In the Motion LUMA requests that the Energy Bureau (i) take notice of the aforementioned; clarify if July 2026 is the correct starting month for compliance with the new reporting requirements as set out in the May 13 Order; (ii) reconsider the templates ordered in the July 15 Order and adopt the Proposed Template² to report on vegetation management progress for transmission and distribution lines in future quarterly reports; and (iii) reinstate the forty-five (45) day post-quarter deadline for submitting the quarterly vegetation management progress reports. Upon review of the Motion, the Energy Bureau **DETERMINES** to:

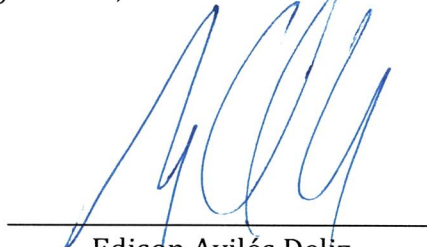
² In the Motion, LUMA informed that it has been working with the Fiscal Oversight and Management Board ("FOMB") and other stakeholders to develop a more detailed, structured, and operationally consistent reporting template to update on vegetation management progress. As a result, LUMA is now using a new reporting template, included as Exhibit 1 ("Proposed Template"), to provide updates on vegetation management to the Puerto Rico Government, the FOMB, and the U.S. Department of Energy.

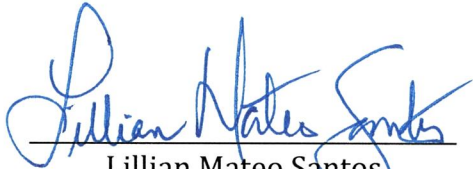


- i. Confirm that **July 2026** is the correct starting month for compliance with the new reporting requirements. Therefore, the first quarterly report is due by mid-November **2026**.
- ii. Adopt the Proposed Template to report on vegetation management progress for transmission and distribution lines in future quarterly reports; and
- iii. Reinstate the forty-five (45) day post-quarter deadline for submitting the quarterly vegetation management progress reports.

The Energy Bureau WARNS that, under Article 6.36 of Act 572014,12 noncompliance with this Resolution and Order, regulations, fines and administrative sanctions.
