**SUBJECT: LUMA's Motion to Submit Responses  
in Compliance with Resolution and Order of July 28,  
2026**

**MOTION TO SUBMIT RESPONSES IN COMPLIANCE  
WITH THE JULY 28 ORDER**

**TO THE HONORABLE PUERTO RICO ENERGY BUREAU:**

**COME NOW** LUMA Energy, LLC and LUMA Energy ServCo, LLC (jointly "LUMA") and respectfully state and request the following:

1. On July 28, 2026, the Honorable Puerto Rico Energy Bureau (the "Energy Bureau") issued a Resolution and Order (the "July 28 Order") directing LUMA to provide a detailed explanation regarding its compliance with the Manual Load Shedding provisions of Procedure No. 17, *Load Shedding*, Revision 1.2 (the "Load Shedding Procedure"), in connection with the Manual Load Shedding ("MLS") event that occurred on July 22, 2026.

2. Specifically, the July 28 Order directed LUMA to submit, at a minimum:

- i. a description of how load shed blocks are rotated during MLS events in accordance with Section 3.1.7 and Appendix C of the Load Shedding Procedure;
- ii. copies of the control room logbook ("bitácora") entries corresponding to the MLS event of July 22, 2026, together with a table identifying, for each load shed block, the time it was shed, the time it was restored, and the total duration of the interruption;

- iii. an identification of any block that remained interrupted in excess of two (2) hours during said event, with an explanation of the cause; and
  - iv. the current status of the SCADA automatic load rotation functionality referenced in Appendix C, the interim measures used to ensure timely rotation while that functionality remains unavailable, and the estimated date for its restoration.”
3. LUMA respectfully submits that the information requested by the Energy Bureau is addressed fully and comprehensively in the document attached hereto as Exhibit 1<sup>1</sup>, which is incorporated herein by reference.
4. To facilitate the Energy Bureau’s review, Exhibit 1 is organized to correspond to each of the information requests identified in the July 28 Order. Part of the information provided therein includes:
- a. the operational processes utilized by LUMA during MLS events and explains how load shed blocks are rotated in accordance with Section 3.1.7 and Appendix C of the Load Shedding Procedure;
  - b. the relevant control room logbook entries for the July 22, 2026, MLS event, together with the corresponding block-by-block interruption data requested by the Energy Bureau; and
  - c. an update concerning the SCADA automatic load rotation functionality and the measures currently employed by LUMA to ensure proper load block rotation.

5. Through Exhibit 1, LUMA provides the information and explanations requested by the Energy Bureau regarding the July 22, 2026, MLS event and LUMA's implementation of the Load Shedding Procedure. LUMA therefore respectfully submits this filing in compliance with the July 28 Order.

**WHEREFORE**, LUMA respectfully requests that the Energy Bureau take notice of the filing of Exhibit 1 and deem LUMA in compliance with the requirements established in the July 28 Order, together with any other relief deemed just and proper.
