RESOLUTION AND ORDER

On July 13, 2026, the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") issued a Resolution and Order ("July 13 Resolution") containing a Draft Distributed Generation and Microgrid Interconnection Regulation ("Revised Preliminary Draft"). Through the July 13 Resolution, the Energy Bureau invited all stakeholders and interested persons to provide their comments and feedback on the Draft Regulation on or before August 14, 2024 and scheduled two Virtual Stakeholder Workshops for August 25, 2026 and September 21, 2026 to evaluate and address stakeholders' comments on Revised Preliminary Draft and seek consensus and solutions that are aligned with public policy. The Energy Bureau also indicated that agendas would be published before each workshop.

In accordance with the July 13 Resolution, the Energy Bureau issued a Resolution and Order with the agenda for the August 25, 2026 Virtual Stakeholder Workshop ("August 25 Workshop") on August 19, 2026 ("August 19 Resolution"). The agenda identified three topics for discussion: (1) simplified process for interconnection, (2) cost allocation (application, studies, and contribution of system upgrades and costs), and (3) meter socket adapters.

On August 25, 2026, the Energy Bureau held the Virtual Stakeholder Workshop; however, there was insufficient time to effectively discuss agenda topics 2 and 3. After consultation with the attendees during the August 25 Workshop, there was consensus to continue discussing topics 2 and 3 at a follow-up Virtual Stakeholder Workshop on Friday, August 28, 2026.

The Energy Bureau now **SCHEDULES** a Virtual Stakeholder Workshop on August 28, 2026, from 9:30 a.m. until 1:00 p.m. with the following agenda.

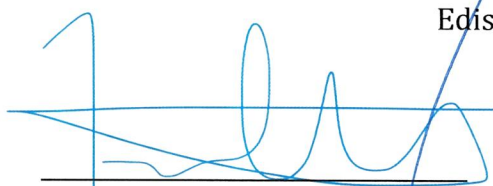

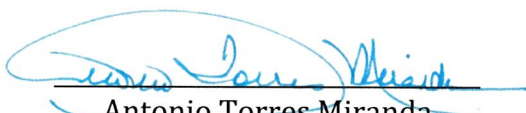
