RESOLUTION AND ORDER

On July 17, 2026, the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") issued a Resolution and Order ("July 17 Resolution") granting ENFIN ENERGY CORP. ("EnFin") until July 24, 2026, to comply with the Resolution and Order issued on July 8, 2026 ("July 8 Resolution"), whereby the Energy Bureau requested EnFin:

1. To explain the nature of the transactions resulting in an income of \$58,967,669.07, the assets transferred, and the basis upon which those proceeds shall be excluded from revenues attributable to electric services in Puerto Rico.
2. To submit its revised revenue figure and clarification duly certified by a Certified Public Accountant CPA, under Art. 4.02 of Regulation 8701¹.

After several interlocutory matters, on August 25, 2026, the Energy Bureau issued a Resolution and Order ("August 25 Resolution") granting EnFin until August 27, 2026, to supplement its August 6 and August 19 Motions complying with the information originally requested through the July 8 and 17 Resolutions.

On August 28, 2026, EnFin filed a document titled *Motion Requesting Brief Additional Term to Submit Supplemental Information* ("August 28 Motion") reporting on the actions to compile and verify the requested information. EnFin indicated that it had been unable to complete the process within the term granted by the Energy Bureau and requested until September 3, 2026, to supplement its August 6 and 19 Motions and comply with the July 8 and 17 Resolutions.

After reviewing the August 28 Motion, the Energy Bureau **GRANTS** EnFin until **September 3, 2026**, to comply with the referenced requirement of information.

The Energy Bureau **WARNS** EnFin that failure to comply with this Resolution may result in the imposition of an administrative fine pursuant to Article 6.36 of Act 57-2014².

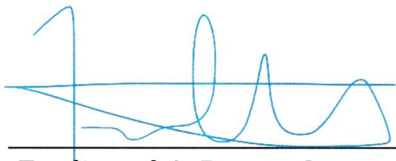
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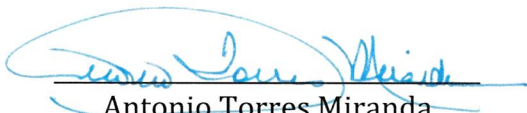
