**MOTION IN COMPLIANCE WITH FINAL RATE ORDER REGARDING
UPDATED REVENUE DECOUPLING MECHANISM**

TO THE HONORABLE PUERTO RICO ENERGY BUREAU:

COME NOW LUMA Energy, LLC and LUMA Energy ServCo, LLC (collectively, "LUMA"), through undersigned counsel, and respectfully state and request as follows:

1. On April 15, 2026, the Honorable Puerto Rico Energy Bureau ("Energy Bureau") issued a *Final Resolution and Order on Electricity Rates* ("Final Rate Order") in the matter of *In Re: Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority Rate Review*, case no. NEPR-AP-2023-0003.

2. Chapter Seven of the Final Rate Order addresses the development and approval of a revenue decoupling mechanism for the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority ("PREPA"), to be implemented by LUMA. The Energy Bureau ordered LUMA to file an updated decoupling mechanism in accordance with the Final Rate Order, containing the formulas, inputs, data sources, and workpapers necessary to implement the decoupling mechanism by September 1, 2026. *See* Final Rate Order, Chapter Seven, Part XLVII.F.

3. In compliance with the Energy Bureau's directives, LUMA hereby submits **Exhibit 1** and its corresponding attachments, containing the updated revenue decoupling mechanism. Exhibit 1 includes the formulas, inputs, data sources, and workpapers necessary to implement the

decoupling mechanism in accordance with the Final Rate Order. Exhibit 1 includes LUMA's explanation of its compliance with the Energy Bureau's requirements. Exhibit 1 also includes supporting analysis to assist the Energy Bureau in its review of the mechanism treatment of potential double-counting and, the Volumetric Rate Adjustment implementation to the participating Rate Classes.

WHEREFORE, LUMA respectfully requests that the Honorable Energy Bureau **take notice** of the foregoing; **deem** LUMA in compliance with the Energy Bureau's directive to file an updated decoupling mechanism in accordance with the Final Rate Order as set forth in Chapter Seven of the Final Rate Order; and **grant** such other and further relief as the Energy Bureau deems just and appropriate.
