RESOLUTION AND ORDER

I. Introduction

On July 13, 2026, the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") issued a Resolution and Order ("July 13 Resolution") containing a Draft Distributed Generation and Microgrid Interconnection Regulation ("Revised Preliminary Draft"). Through the July 13 Resolution, the Energy Bureau invited all stakeholders and interested persons to provide their comments and feedback on the Revised Preliminary Draft Regulation on or before August 14, 2024 and scheduled two Virtual Stakeholder Workshops for August 25, 2026 and September 21, 2026 to evaluate and address stakeholders' comments on Revised Preliminary Draft and seek consensus and solutions aligned with public policy. The Energy Bureau also indicated that agendas would be published before each workshop.

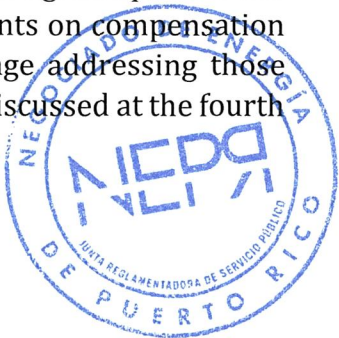
II. Virtual Stakeholder Workshop Agenda

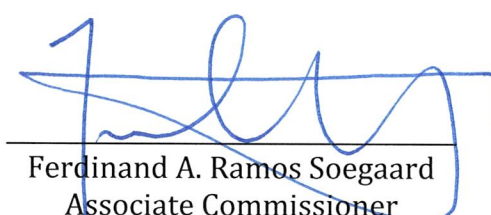

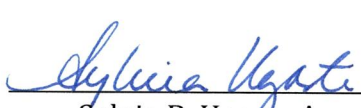
