SUBJECT: Multi-Site Gas Supply Contract

RESOLUTION AND ORDER

The Puerto Rico Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") has received a communication from the Puerto Rico Public-Private Partnerships Authority's Procurement Office ("3PPO") about the potential implementation of the tolling agreement provisions in the Multi-Site Gas Supply Contract¹ with NFE.² The communication references and includes certain prior communications about this matter. However, based on the information available to the Energy Bureau, the record of communications provided appears to be incomplete.

The Energy Bureau **ORDERS** PREPA to undertake, through 3PPO, all necessary actions to obtain and produce to the Energy Bureau the complete record of communications relating to the potential implementation, consideration, negotiation, or invocation of the tolling agreement provisions under the Multi-Site Gas Supply Contract. Such production shall include all communications exchanged among or involving 3PPO, NFE, the Puerto Rico Public-Private Partnerships Authority ("P3A"), Genera, PREPA, LUMA,³ and any other person or entity about this matter, including any related correspondence, notices, requests, responses, attachments, or other written communications.

PREPA shall ensure that the complete production required is submitted to the Energy Bureau no later than **12:00 p.m. on September 29, 2026**.

Going forward, PREPA shall ensure that the Energy Bureau is contemporaneously provided with copies of all communications exchanged among or involving 3PPO, NFE, P3A, Genera, PREPA, LUMA, or any other person or entity about the potential implementation, consideration, negotiation, or invocation of the tolling agreement provisions under the Multi-Site Gas Supply Contract, including any communications relating to actions taken or proposed in connection therewith.

The Energy Bureau **WARNS** that, under Article 6.36 of Act 57-2014, noncompliance with this Resolution and Order, regulations and/or applicable laws may carry the imposition of fines and administrative sanctions.⁴
